Overview

Born raised and trained in urban USA, I moved to Denmark in 1973 to pursue my careers as a psychologist and jazz musician and composer.

I had a mobile clinical practice servicing clients over most of the country, with a base clinic in Holstebro under the Danish National Health Service (Dansk Offentlige Sygesikring) for subsidised crisis intervention and psychotherapy. As an organisational psychologist, I served both governmental and private organisations as a trainer, consultant and coach for individuals and groups.

I worked in Malaysia from 2011 to 2016, as a clinical therapist, freelance trainer, coach, researcher and coordinator for international business development, bringing Malaysian talent and resources together with international partners.

Upon returning to Denmark, I've maintained activities in Europe, North America and Malaysia/Southeast Asia, including affiliations with collaborating organisations and individual clients, both face to face and online.

I'm intent on utilising my long and rich career as clinical and organizational psychologist and jazz musician and composer, to

create effective, unique and empowering services for interested local and international individuals and communities.

1973 After two summer consultantships, moved to Copenhagen, where until 1980 was consultant to Danish substance abuse programs, working with clients and staff, and offering training and treatment skills to other organizations.

1971 Invited by Dr. Jens Mathiassen, Institute for Social Medicine, Copenhagen, to Denmark as summer consultant to substance abuse treatment programs, primarily in the Copenhagen area.

1971 Completed Master's degree and joined the faculty of City University of New York, Kingsborough College, U.S.A., establishing the *Human Development Workshop*, with a staff of 8 ex-substance abusers, studying at the university and offering counselling and information to students and faculty.
