The 2020 Christian Aid week appeal was difficult as the usual door-to-door collection and the fund-raising activities we rely on were curtailed by the lockdown. This year we were hoping to fully fund a Beekeeping project in the North of Burundi, setting up a training centre of excellence and a cooperative for the processing of local honey. Our target was £23,905.00.

To date, the generosity of the Island's Christians has raised £19,724.39! Which is beyond fantastic, in the most challenging of circumstances. Burundi is one of the worlds poorest countries and every person in the Isle of Man who has given has made a tremendous difference to families living in the direct of circumstances in Burundi. Churches Alive in Mann is supporting an appeal to to raise the final £4,181 to reach the target. Can you help please.
