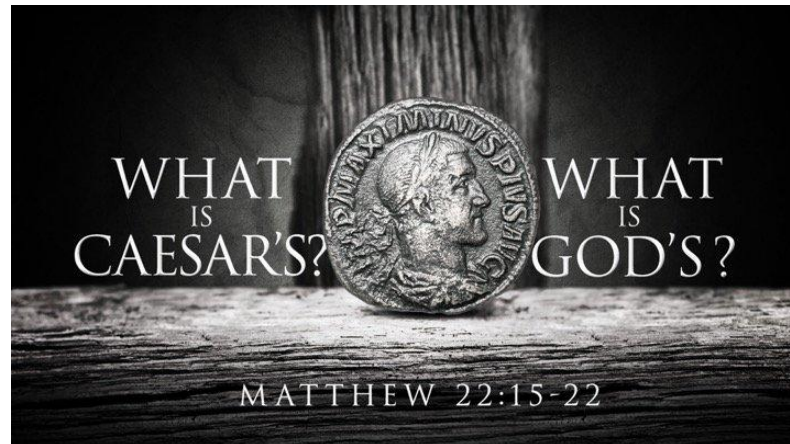


Lonan & Laxey Pew Notes
