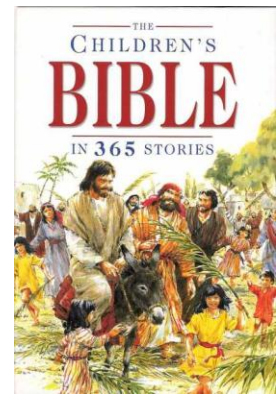
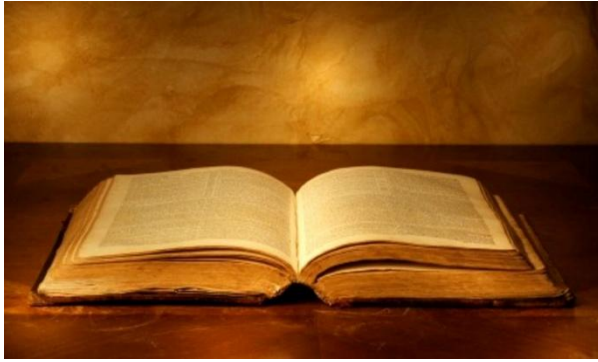


**Lonan & Laxey Pew Notes**
