What do we propose? Each day tour with lunch included, in a place of our choice:

Day 1 *

Departure from the Hotel and visit to the Câmara de Lobos area – Eira do Serrado – Curral das Freiras – Return to the Hotel.

Day 2

Departure from the Hotel and Funchal city tour (on foot) – Monte – Jardim Monte Palace (cable car) – Return to the Hotel (Minibus).

Day 3 *

Departure from the Hotel and Visit to Santana – Porto da Cruz – Caniçal area - Return to the Hotel.

It includes:

- Transportation to and from the hotel (outside Funchal, there are additional fees);
- Lunch or dinner with drinks included;
- madeira wine Tasting;
- 1 one-way cable car trip;
- entrance to the Monte Palace ´s Garden;
- basket car descent (depending on the day of the week. No trips are made on Sundays);
- qualified drive and guide;
- personal accident insurance and liability insurance.

It does not include:

- Accommodation and Travel;
- Meals or drinks not described in the included point.
- Anything that is not described in the "it includes" segment.
