Come and learn about some of the aspects that are part of the ethnography in its various aspects:

- Funchal Marketplace - be enchanted by the flavours and vibrant colours of the products on display, and discover what the land has to offer to Madeirans, making out its peculiar gastronomy;
- Madeira Embroidery - all manufactured, loaded with centenary traditions, originating from the settlement of the island;
- Ethnographic Museum of Ribeira Brava - it shows us the "becoming" of the island over the centuries, still perceptible today in places, traditions, ways and habits of the Madeiran people;
- The Whale Museum - travel to the 60s and get to know an activity that marked the economy of two communities in Madeira - Porto Moniz and Caniçal;
- Serra d'Água and Moinho de Santana - two places that show activities of the past: sawmilling and milling of cereals;
- Santana Theme Park - a place where traditions, folklore and everything that still exists within our ethnography are reproduced and explained: - Wine and Vineyard Museum - visiting us would not be the same without knowing a space dedicated to wine and, of course, tasting it.



The items indicated above are part of the proposed program and it is with it that we intend to show who the Madeirans are:

Day 1 - Funchal city tour - Visit to an embroidery factory or the Embroidery Museum - Câmara de Lobos - Return to the hotel;

Day 2 - Visit to the village of Ribeira Brava - Porto Moniz - S. Vicente - Return to the Hotel;

Day 3 - Visit to the village of Caniçal - Santana - S. Jorge - Return to the Hotel.
