All Muslims love and praise Muhammad # more than everyone else on earth, only after Allah. This is but natural to do, being a follower of Muhammad #, while this is considered by many non Muslims as an exaggeration.

But, what becomes worth noting is, if Non Muslims of high eminence, speak affably and praising Muhammad # with remarkable ascriptions to him #. Another notable point is that they spoke so high about Muhammad # but hardly anyone of them became a Muslim later in their respective lives.

Let us learn about few of the most notable Non Muslims speaking in reverence of Muhammad .

- ➤ MICHAEL HART Mathematician, Professor of Astronomy, Physics, History: My choice of Muhammad ® to lead the list of the world's most influential persons may surprise some readers and may be questioned by others, but he was the only man in history who was supremely successful on both the religious and secular level. The 100: A Ranking Of The Most Influential Persons In History, New York, 1978, p. 33
- ➤ WILLIAM MONTOGMERY WATT Professor {Emeritus} of Arabic & Islamic Studies, University of Edinburgh, Scotland: His readiness to undergo persecutions for his beliefs, the high moral character of the men who believed in him and looked up to him as leader, and the greatness of his ultimate achievement all argue his fundamental integrity. To suppose Muhammad an impostor raises more problems than it solves. Moreover, none of the great figures of history is so poorly appreciated in the West as Muhammad. - ➤ ALPHONSE de LAMARTINE French poet and Statesman: If greatness of purpose, smallness of means and astounding results are the three criteria to judge any human genius, who could dare to compare any great man in modern history with (Muhammad)? This man moved not only armies, legislation, empires, peoples and dynasties, but millions of men in one-third of the then-inhabited world; and more than that he moved the altars, the gods, the religions, the ideas, the beliefs and souls......... - ➤ JOHN WILLIAM DRAPER American Scientist, Philosopher and Historian: "Four years after the death of Justinian, C.E. 569, was born at Mecca, in Arabia the man who, of all men exercised the greatest influence upon the human race... - ➤ MOHANDAS KARAMCHAND GANDHI Father of Nation (Independent India), greatest freedom fighter of Indian Independence: "...I became more than ever convinced that it was not the sword that won a place for Islam in those days in the scheme of life. - ➤ JAMES A MICHENER American writer of more than 40 famous books: No other religion in history spread so rapidly as Islam. Like almost every major prophet before him, Muhammad fought shy of serving as the transmitter of God's word sensing his own inadequacy. But the Angel commanded 'Read'. At Muhammad's own death an attempt was made to deify him, but the man who was to become his administrative successor killed the hysteria with one of the noblest speeches in religious history: 'If there are any among you who worshiped Muhammad, he is dead.
