Town Board Meeting

April 10, 2017 Minutes

Chairman Van Asten called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present were Chairman Mike Van Asten, Supervisor Shane Robley, Supervisor Dennis Van Vreede, Debbie VanderHeiden Clerk/Treasurer. Also present were 2 Residents 2 Guest.

- d. Payment for Benches for the 4-H Club. Motion by Supervisor Robley to pay 250.00 per bench to On The Go 4-H club and to pay 500.00 to the other 4-H club for the Picnic table, second by Supervisor Van Vreede. Motion carried.

Vouchers: Vouchers 7487 - 7511 were presented for payment. Motion by Supervisor Robley to approve vouchers 7487 - 7511, second by Supervisor Van Vreede. Motion carried.
