GARBAGE INFO

Garbage bins should only contain household garbage. Yard waste is not permitted. Make sure to place your garbage bin several feet away from your recycling bin so the truck arms can get around the bin.

Also a reminder that garbage should be at the curb by 5 am.

DOG LICENSE



All dogs in the town need to be licensed and must have proof of rabies for license. Fees are as follows: spayed/neutered - \$3.00; not spayed/neutered - \$8.00. License can be applied for when paying taxes or by mail. A self addressed envelope is needed if you want your tags sent in mail.
