Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please be advised that significant roadworks are slated to commence at the intersection of Melbourne and Kilmore roads on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2022. All GisBus services, including school runs will be affected significantly.

The intersection is expected to be closed to all traffic until 11<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

School children's collection and drop-offs will be altered by these roadworks. Morning collections at Joseph Avenue and Jacksons Creek Bus Stop should not be affected unduly. Collections after Jacksons Creek, however, **may** run up to ten minutes late. It is therefore imperative that you notify GisBus of student absence well in advance of collection time to facilitate our easy running. We ask that students be at their collection points at the same time as is currently advertised.

Afternoon collections from school will continue as normal. We may, however, need to place children upon different buses to minimize delays. This means you may see a different driver. Drop off times for students will necessarily alter as we work to manage passage around the roadworks.

In the afternoon, we have **no** capacity to collect students from the Gisborne library to deliver anywhere on or about Kilmore Road. The only option we have available is for these students to go to the Coles bus stop for collection at 4:17, which will travel via Gisborne Railway Station and the 4:29 train pickup.

Current plans indicate that route 473 will depart the Keily Road Bus Stop then travel along Howey Street, and into Aitken Street. The Rodney Street, Calthorpe Street and Telegraph Hotel bus stops will not be in use until the roadworks are completed. Application is being made for a temporary bus stop on Howey Street adjacent to Rodney Street.
