*The Dream is **Maurette's** very first live concert recording and it truly captures the essence of her heart for God. For this effort, she was awarded the **2008 Stellar Award for Praise and Worship CD of the Year**. Her daughter Jada received the **2008 Stellar Award for Children's Performance** of the Year for her song, "I am what God says I am", also featured on *The Dream*.*

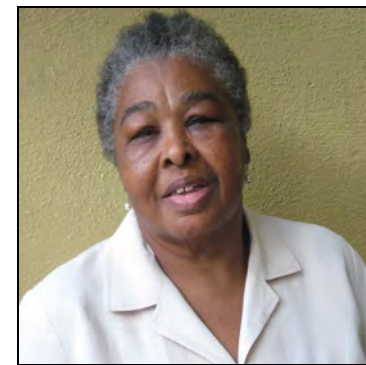

Stan Jones was born in the small town of Clarksdale Mississippi and began demonstrating his range of artistic gifts at age 12. With music surrounding him from very early on, to see him display some musical ability was almost to be expected. But to see where the Singer/Songwriter/Producer's life is today - a highly sought after talent whose gifts have continued to amass inevitable awards and recognition and

where he is headed, no one could have pinpointed or mapped that out except God.

As the eldest son in a musically inclined family, Stan grew up listening to an array of artists. While early favorites included Commissioned and The Winans, beyond the radio, his mother (who still holds the position of Choir Director) and father (a former R&B guitarist now Pastor) kept Stan immersed in a variety of sounds that peaked his interest and sparked a deep desire.

Leaving home immediately after High School to handle production duties and play drums for The Bolton Brothers laid the foundation for Stan's career path. During that time, any remnants of music simply being a hobby were washed away and replaced with the passion of life's purpose. Stan was soon afforded the prospect to be mentored by legendary quartet The Williams Brothers which subsequently led to his first album placement: "What's Wrong With Right" on Doug Williams' solo debut. As Stan continued to diligently pursue his purpose, a consistent flow of opportunities presented themselves and Jones has had the privilege thus far to work with artists including Yolanda Adams, Marvin Sapp and The Canton Spirituals. A notable highlight of Jones' career to date is the success of break-out new artist Brian Courtney Wilson. Jones produced Wilson's entire debut record Just Love and wrote the smash single "All I Need," a song which has spent almost a year and a half in the Top 15 of Gospel radio charts.

"It's clearly the grace of God that has stretched me beyond what others have been able to do; allowing me to write and produce hit songs from quartet, to traditional choir, to contemporary gospel. I thank God for the prosperity I've experienced thus far," shares Jones.

In early 2011 Jones will have opportunity to share another dimension of his talent as he looks forward to the release of a solo record. Today, the two-time Grammy nominee, seven-time Stellar Award winner and thirteen-time Mississippi Gospel

REV. JIMMIE & FIRST LADY SHIRLEY GARNER

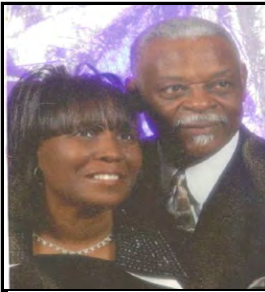
