It's been almost two years since we published our business plan and launched our share offer. Since then, we've raised over £600,000 through investors, grants, donations and fundraising events. As a community, we now own the Rose & Crown Inn and have started renovations – an incredible achievement!

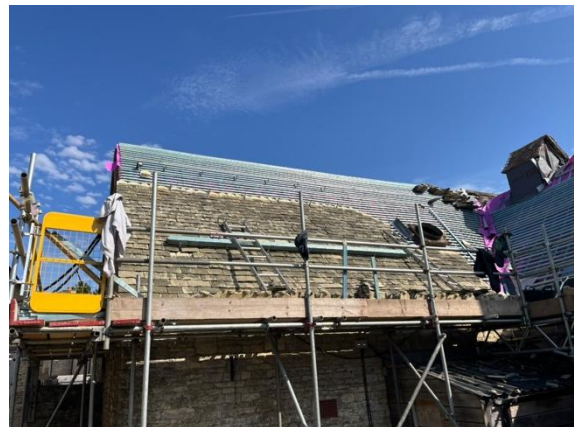
Grants and Funding

We're delighted to announce we have been awarded a £5,000 grant from the [Summerfield Trust](#). The funding will be used to improve accessibility at the pub. Since 1989, the Trust has been championing Gloucestershire charities and community initiatives and we're incredibly grateful for their support of our project.

In June, the government announced [a £61m fund to encourage communities to preserve cherished local assets like pubs](#) – a similar initiative to the Community Ownership Fund that was suspended in May 2024. We are closely monitoring whether this funding will be implemented under the new Prime Minister.

Renovation Programme

The phase one renovation programme is well underway! A section of the building has been scaffolded, and re-roofing work has finally started. Electrical and plumbing trades have also begun internal work, and our new bike racks have been installed. We're grateful to our volunteers for their help with the strip-out.
