Grants and Funding

We expect to hear back about our application to the [National Lottery Heritage Fund](#) in early June. Fingers crossed!

Our stage one application to the [Summerfield Trust](#) for a grant to fund accessible toilet facilities was successful. We're now preparing our stage two application which will be submitted for review at the next trustees' meeting in late July.

We also applied to the [Take a Stand](#) scheme run by Life Cycle. This scheme provides and installs free bike stands for eligible businesses and community organisations. Our application was successful and we're currently working with Life Cycle to find a suitable location for the bike stands and schedule the installation date.

Donations

We are grateful to our supporters who have generously donated a commercial glass washer and commercial electric hob. We have also been provided with a secure offsite storage facility where we are storing high-value items during the renovation works. Thank you!

A huge thank you to everyone who attended our pop-up pub on 16th May. Despite the unseasonably cool weather, the event was busy throughout the day. We achieved fantastic sales of £4.4k from bar, food and merchandise.
