## **A Message to Sterling Green Residents — May 2026**

On behalf of **Amory Protective Services**, we thank you for entrusting us with the safety of your community. Our mission is straightforward: **Observe. Report. Deter.** We are security professionals — not law enforcement — and we operate within that role with precision and purpose.

Our guards patrol every street in Sterling Green on an **hourly basis** in clearly marked patrol vehicles. That consistent, visible presence is one of the most proven methods of deterring crime before it occurs. We do not seek confrontation — we prevent it. When incidents arise, we document them accurately and work closely with both the **Harris County Sheriff's Office** and **Constable Precinct 3** as appropriate.

We understand that some residents may expect dramatic action from their

security team. In reality, the most effective security is often the kind where nothing happens — because a potential offender saw our patrol vehicle and drove away. That outcome doesn't make headlines, but it protects your home.

We also want to take a moment to clarify the scope of our services. **Amory Protective Services is contracted to provide security for the Sterling Green community as a whole** — including common areas, entry points, streets, and the general neighborhood perimeter. Our patrol coverage benefits every resident by maintaining a safe environment throughout the community. We are not contracted to provide dedicated security for individual homes or personal property. Residents with concerns specific to their household are encouraged to contact the **Harris County Sheriff's Office** or **Constable Precinct 3** directly, and we will always support those efforts during our patrol hours.



**Important Notice Regarding Coverage Schedule:** Amory Protective Services is no longer patrolling 7 days per week in Sterling Green. Our current schedule is **Thursday through Sunday, 7:00 PM – 7:00 AM**. Residents should be aware that **reduced patrol days may result in a modest increase in property crime and vandalism** on unpatrolled nights. We encourage residents to remain vigilant, secure vehicles and property, and report suspicious activity directly to the **Harris County Sheriff's Office** or **Constable Precinct 3** on off-patrol nights.

All incidents are documented and coordinated with the Harris County Sheriff's Office and Constable Precinct 3 when appropriate.



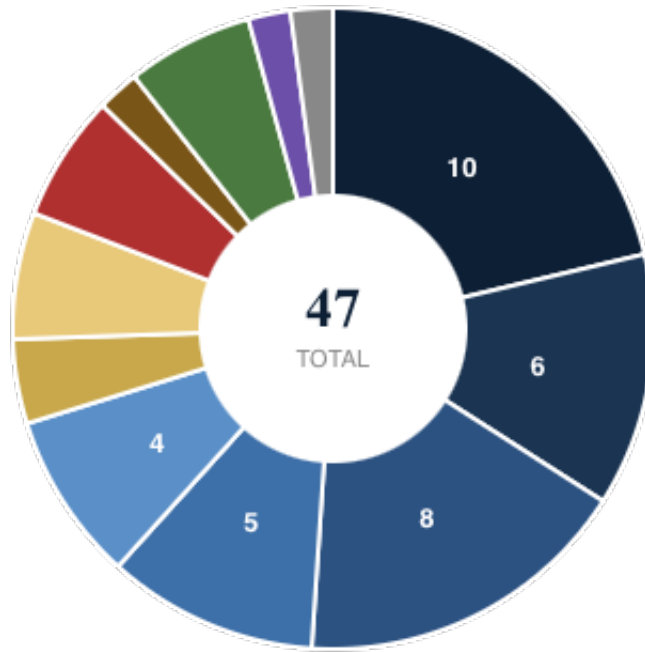
### **Deter**
