January 6th is Epiphany. Epiphany is the day the star rose in the East to lead the magi to the Christ child. The story in the Bible is one of my favorites. I think it's one of my favorites because it speaks to my longing to be drawn into the mystery, my desire for God to send me a guiding light, and my constant search for the wonder of the holy in my own life. It is probably these longings that drew me to be a pastor. In my job, I am immersed in mystery. I get to discern what God is saying through the Scriptures, the things that happen in my day, and the people around me. I walk with others as they discern what God is up to in their lives. I look for Jesus everywhere, and I am on a quest to find him for myself and for the people in my congregation. It's not just pastors that want to find God though. We all harbor longings for the presence of God and a guiding light in the darkness.

The Gospel of the Epiphany story is that God provides a guide to lead the way to Jesus. For the magi, it was a new light in the sky, one they hadn't seen before. It guided the magi to a different place and culture. They had to consult their astrology books. They asked others for help. Looking for wisdom, they investigated the Scriptures. On their journey, they encountered Herod, who was up to no good, and even though they were supposedly wise, they failed to detect his ill intent. However, God gave them a dream as a warning, and they were wise to pay attention to that. The light in the sky, the dreams, the Scriptures, the study of their star books all led them to the cradle of Jesus where they knelt and worshiped and offered their rare and beautiful gifts.

Epiphany is the story of the spiritual life, and we all have a spiritual life! We travel in the dark following the stars that God provides, and to the inner workings of our hearts. God speaks in our dreams, the people around us, and our life experiences. The route is not certain or obvious, but God provides guidance along the way. Our deepest desire is to receive the gift of Jesus and to worship him as we offer our own gifts to the glory of God. Follow the star. Trust that God is leading you. God will bring you to Jesus, and you will be welcome there, you and your amazing gifts that glorify God!
