Diaper Bank


At our April meeting, the Council voted that Christ Lutheran Church would host a diaper bank in our building. We had received a request from the Walworth County Food and Diaper Bank to be a distribution site. People from the Darien/Sharon area who used the service located in Elkhorn expressed that paying for gas to get to the diaper bank was becoming an issue. We had conversations with other services in the Sharon community to make sure we were not overlapping services or providing for a need already addressed. We will not have to collect the diapers and products. The Walworth Co. Food and Diaper Bank will supply us with our inventory. We will offer baby diapers and wipes, adult incontinence products, and feminine hygiene products. Our role will be housing the diapers and opening the building so that people can use the service. At this time we estimate we will have the diaper bank open twice monthly. If you have ideas, or would like to help with this ministry in any way, please contact the church.

Faithful Innovation

Our congregation will be participating in a synod led process called Faithful Innovations beginning this May. Our members Carol Frederick, Marie Rithamel, and Denise Gibbons will be part of our Faithful Innovations Team. The team will gather with other teams from other Lutheran churches in our area a few times throughout the year and Lutherdale Bible Camp. The team will be praying about how God is present in our congregation and how God might be leading us. Stay tuned, because eventually, they will be sharing what they learn with you and will be inviting the congregation to be praying and acting too. Thank you to those who are participating on the team.
