ATTN: Senior Parents!



Each year at Project Grad, we display individual posters prepared by the seniors' parents. These posters are made up of a collage of photos of the graduate growing up and usually include baby photos through present day photos. The posters will be displayed at Project Grad on May 31st, in the area referred to as "Memory Lane." The kids love to walk through "Memory Lane" and see all of their classmates' photos.

We hope every senior will have a poster displayed so as not to feel left out! Now is a great time to start preparing posters! You can cut the photos in creative shapes, add colored backgrounds, write comments or headlines about the photos, etc... Be as creative as you want, but we ask that you PLEASE follow the guidelines below.

GENERAL MEMORY LANE POSTER GUIDELINES:

1. **POSTER SIZE LIMIT IS 24" X 28"** – Exception: Costco posters (finished size is 20" x 30") are acceptable. Please **DO NOT** use foam core board, staples, Styrofoam, or tacks on your poster!
2. **ALL POSTERS MUST BE DESIGNED VERTICALLY (PORTRAIT) TO ALLOW PLENTY OF ROOM FOR ALL STUDENT POSTERS ON MEMORY LANE!** With over 300 posters, space available for display is limited!
3. **STUDENT'S FIRST AND LAST NAME** ideally is on the **FRONT** of the poster – if not, please provide student name, and a contact number for pick up on the back just in case!
4. **LAMINATE** your poster before turning it in! Unlaminated posters can tear and fall off the display.
5. **ALL POSTERS MUST HAVE PUNCH HOLES, WITH METAL GROMMETS, IN ALL FOUR CORNERS** – they are tied to a grid for display FedEx/Kinkos, and Office Depot will add metal grommets during lamination.
6. **POSTERS ARE DUE BY 2 PM, THURSDAY, MAY 30th, IN THE STUDENT STORE!**
7. Posters will be brought home by your student at the end of Project Grad. Please remind your student to take their poster home after the party. Remaining/forgotten posters will be available for pick-up on Saturday, June 1st, in the large gym during event clean up. ALL POSTERS MUST BE PICKED UP BY 12PM ON JUNE 1st. We cannot guarantee the availability of posters left at the school after June 1st!
