RESOLUTION NO. 2024-1

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO REIMBURSE
INTERIM FUNDS USED TO PAY WATER PROJECT
COSTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH PENNVEST
REPAYMENT AND/OR NONREPAYMENT LOANS.

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (the "Authority"), has determined to replace the Edgewood Tank, improve the Greenbranch Pumping Station and undertake other improvements to the water system owned and operated by the Authority (the "Water Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to finance the costs of the Water Project, the Authority intends to seek funding from the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority ("PENNVEST") consisting of a repayment loan and/or a nonrepayment loan in the total amount of approximately \$4,938,893 (together, the "PENNVEST Funding");

WHEREAS, The Authority has determined that it intends to pay costs of the Water Project on an interim basis from its water system revenues and reserves (the "Interim Funds"), and reasonably expects to reimburse some or all of such Interim Funds from proceeds of the PENNVEST Funding, as and when received; and

WHEREAS, Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 of the United States Internal Revenue Service, codified at 26 C.F.R. § 1.150-2 (the "Reimbursement Regulations"), requires a "declaration of official intent" to reimburse specified accounts or funds for capital expenditures advanced in connection with the capital project from a "reimbursement bond", as defined in the Reimbursement Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Authority hereafter may advance Interim Funds to pay costs and expenses of the Water Project. All or some of the Interim Funds are not intended to finance the Water Project on a permanent basis, but on an interim basis only.
2. The Authority declares its intention to reimburse all or some of the Interim Funds paid for the Water Project from proceeds of the PENNVEST Funding, up to approximately \$4,938,893.
3. The Authority hereby declares that this Resolution shall constitute a "declaration of official intent" as contemplated by the Reimbursement Regulations.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-2

OF RED LION MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY ("AUTHORITY") AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A WATER REVENUE NOTE, IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$4,938,893, TO THE PENNSYLVANIA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AUTHORITY ("PENNVEST"), TO CONSTRUCT IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AUTHORITY'S PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM, AND PAY RELATED EXPENSES; APPROVING THE FORM, TERMS, AND EXECUTION OF A FUNDING AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS ("FUNDING DOCUMENTS"); AND APPROVING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, this Authority has determined to construct improvements to its public Water system ("Water System"), and pay related costs and expenses ("Water Project"), by issuing a water revenue note to the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority ("PennVest") to be entitled "Debt Obligation," in the maximum principal amount of \$4,938,893 ("Debt Obligation"), to be issued to PennVest; and

WHEREAS, in order to finance the Water Project, this Authority intends to issue the Debt Obligation, execute the Funding Documents and to take all other actions required by Penn Vest to accept the Debt Obligation; and

WHEREAS, the Debt Obligation shall be secured by a pledge of and security interest in this Authority's Water System revenues, with the priority and as otherwise described in the Funding Documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of this Authority, as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to finance the cost of the Water Project, this Authority hereby authorizes the issuance of the Debt Obligation to PennVest, and approves the execution and delivery of the Funding Documents, including any amendments or supplements resulting from an increase or decrease in the final principal amount of the Debt Obligation, and all other action necessary and appropriate to finance the Water Project pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act, 53 Pa. C.S. Ch. 56, and the Funding Documents.

SECTION 2. The Debt Obligation shall be secured by the Funding Documents, to the extent and in the manner provided therein, including various covenants to timely repay the Debt Obligation, as more fully set forth in the Funding Documents, to finance the Water Project and the pay the principal and interest due on the Debt Obligation. The Debt Obligation shall not in any

manner pledge the full faith, credit or taxing power of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the "Commonwealth"), or of the Borough of Red Lion, York County, Pennsylvania, or any other political subdivision of the Commonwealth.

SECTION 3. The forms, terms, and conditions of the Funding Documents, to be substantially in the forms provided by PennVest and counsel to this Authority, are hereby approved. The Chairman or Vice Chairman of this Authority is hereby authorized to execute the Funding Documents, subject to changes and modifications, if any, including the final principal amount of the Debt Obligation, as may be approved by such Chairman or Vice Chairman, the execution of the Funding Documents to be conclusive evidence of such approval, and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary of this Authority is hereby authorized to cause the corporate seal of this Authority to be affixed thereto and to attest the same. The Chairman or Vice Chairman of this Authority is further authorized to acknowledge, as appropriate, the same on behalf of this Authority and to deliver the Funding Documents to PennVest.

SECTION 4. Officers of this Authority are authorized and directed to execute and seal the Funding Documents and do all other acts that may be necessary and proper to carry out this Resolution and the undertakings of this Authority in the Funding Documents and in connection with the Water Project.

SECTION 5. The Debt Obligation shall be repaid in the amounts and on the dates consistent with the terms of PennVest's Funding Offer, as the same may be amended, and the final Funding Documents. The Debt Obligation shall be subject to early repayment as provided in the Funding Documents.

SECTION 6. The information and representations contained in the application for PennVest funding (the "Application"), in the form submitted to PennVest, are hereby ratified and confirmed, with such subsequent, necessary, and appropriate variations, omissions, and insertions, if any, as have been submitted to PennVest by this Authority, including those necessary to reflect the final terms of the Funding Documents. Reliance by PennVest on representations contained in the Application, as may be amended by the final terms of the Funding Documents, as well as any additional investigation required by PennVest in connection with the Debt Obligation, is hereby authorized.

SECTION 7. Upon receipt, the proceeds of the Debt Obligation shall be applied by this Authority to undertake the Water Project, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Application and the Funding Documents.

SECTION 8. The Debt Obligation shall not be deemed to constitute a tax-exempt obligation for purposes of Sections 103(b)(2) or 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

SECTION 9. Officers of this Authority are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed on behalf of this Authority to execute any and all papers and documents and to do and cause to be done any and all actions and things necessary or proper to carry out the language and intent of this Resolution, the Debt Obligation and the Funding Documents.

SECTION 10. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

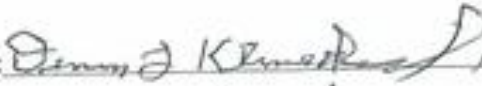

OTHER CHARGES FOR FURNISHING WATER
SERVICE FROM THE WATER SYSTEM OF RED
LION MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (the "Authority") is a general municipality authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended (the "Act"), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 5601-5622;

WHEREAS, the Authority has the authority pursuant to Section 5607(d)(9) of the Act to fix, alter, charge and collect rates and other charges for the provision of water service to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to set the rates and other charges for the provision of water service by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective for all bills for services rendered on or after January 1, 2025, the Authority hereby fixes, adopts, establishes and imposes for water service the following rates and charges set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. All prior water rate schedules or resolutions of the Authority are hereby repealed to the extent inconsistent herewith or necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions or the application of any of its provisions shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not

affect or impair the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the resolution and it is hereby declared as the intent of the Authority that this resolution would have been enacted if such unconstitutional, illegal or valid provision was not included.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be effective at 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2025.

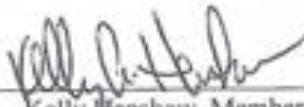

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (the "Authority") is a general municipality authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended (the "Act"), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 5601-5622;

WHEREAS, the Authority has the authority pursuant to Section 5607(d)(9) of the Act to fix, alter, charge and collect rates and other charges for the provision of sewer service to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to set the rates and other charges for the provision of sewer service by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective for all bills for services rendered on or after January 1, 2025, the Authority hereby fixes, adopts, establishes and imposes for sewer service the following rates and charges:

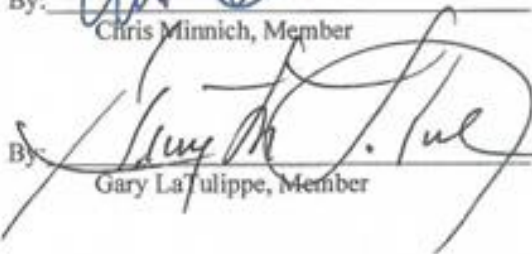

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CERTAIN FEES
AND CHARGES OF THE RED LION
MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (“Authority”) is a general municipality authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended (the “Act”), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 5601-5622; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has adopted rules and regulations governing its water and sewer systems (the “*Water Rules*” and “*Sewer Rules*”) pursuant to authority granted by Section 5607(d)(17) of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the power pursuant to Section 5607(d)(18) of the Act to enter into contracts for the bulk sale and purchase of water and services; and

WHEREAS, Section 8(f) of the Water Rules provides that the Authority shall charge a turn-on fee for the restoration of service following a shut-off due to nonpayment of a consumer’s bill; and

WHEREAS, Section 10(d) of the Water Rules provides that an owner of a property requesting installation of water service is required to pay a tapping fee prior to the installation of the meter; and

WHEREAS, Section 10(d) of the Water Rules provides that the Authority shall charge a fee for the removal of meters should it be necessary to remove a meter for any reason unless the removal is required by the Water Department of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 10(e) of the Water Rules provides that the Authority may charge a fee for turn-off or turn-on of service requested by a consumer; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has power pursuant to Section 5607(d)(24) of the Act and Section 10(d) of the Water Rules provides that the Authority may charge installation and tapping fees for the connection of new consumers to the Authority water system; and

WHEREAS, Section 19(g) of the Water Rules and Section 20(e) of the Sewer Rules provide that the Authority may assess fees for costs incurred for engineering review and legal review of development plans submitted to the Authority containing water or sewer line extensions, as well as costs incurred for the inspection of such finished lines; and

WHEREAS, Section 25(b) of the Water Rules and Section 17(b) of the Sewer Rules provide that the Authority may establish an initial deposit fee for hearings on billing disputes when requested by consumers; and

WHEREAS, Section 25(b) of the Water Rules and Section 17(b) of the Sewer Rules provide that the Authority Board may appoint a hearing officer for the purpose of hearing testimony and preparing a written decision on any billing dispute; and

WHEREAS, Section 32 of the Water Rules and Section 25 of the Sewer Rules provide that the Authority may adopt other miscellaneous fees and charges for services rendered to consumers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. The Members of the Authority hereby adopt and approve the schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "A" as the schedule of applicable Authority rates for bulk water service, discontinuance of service, new services, miscellaneous charges and plan review, and such rates shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the rates contained therein are repealed, modified or superseded.

SECTION 2. The Members of the Authority hereby appoint the Authority Superintendent as the hearing officer to hear billing disputes. The hearing officer will only hear disputes in which a proper claim is filed and deposit paid in accordance with the Water Rules or Sewer Rules.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions or the application of any of its provisions shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the resolution and it is hereby declared as the intent of the Authority that this resolution would have been enacted as if such unconstitutional, illegal or valid provision was not included.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be effective at 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2025.
