³He subdued peoples under us, and nations under our feet.

The princes of the peoples gather as the people of the God of Abraham.

Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled." ⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, ⁴⁶ and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah^[a] is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day,

⁵¹ While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. ^[c] ⁵² And they worshiped him, and ^[d] returned to Jerusalem with great joy; ⁵³ and they were continually in the temple blessing God. ^[e]
