Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. - Matthew 3:2

God was coming to live among his people. John the Baptist was sent to prepare the way of the Lord. John proclaimed "a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" (Luke 3:3). During Advent we confess our sins, acknowledging that we need the Savior born in Bethlehem. In humble repentance we prepare to welcome the Lamb of God, the Lamb who came to die on the cross as the sacrifice for the sins of the world.

The Lord reigns, let the earth rejoice. - Psalm 97:1

During this season, at home and in church, we light candles on Advent wreaths to mark the passing weeks. The candle for the third Sunday of Advent is often a pink or rose color to represent our joyful anticipation of Christ's birth. Its symbolism comes from the Scripture reading appointed for that day: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice" (Philippians 4:4).

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for he has visited and redeemed his people. - Luke 1:68

Our Advent season of waiting lasts only four weeks. The Old Testament people of God waited for centuries for the coming of the Messiah, the Redeemer of Israel. When the time was right, "God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law" (Galatians 4:4-5). During Advent, we, too, wait for the fulfillment of Jesus' promise, "Surely I am coming soon" (Revelation 22:20). As God's redeemed people, we offer up our Advent prayer, "Come, Lord Jesus!"

COME TO US ANEW, AND BY YOUR GRACE, ASSIST US TO RECEIVE YOU WITH JOY, AS THE SHEPHERDS; WITH GRATITUDE, AS SIMEON; WITH OBEDIENCE, AS MARY; WITH LOVE. AS YOU HAVE LOVED US. EVEN SO, COME LORD JESUS. AMEN

Isaiah 11:1-10 (vv. 1-3, 4-6, 8-10) Romans 15: 4-13 (vv. 4-6, 7-9, 11-13)

A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. ² The spirit of the LORD shall rest on him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of

knowledge and the fear of the LORD. ³ His delight shall be in the fear of the LORD.

He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide by what his ears hear;

⁴ but with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

⁵ Righteousness shall be the belt around his waist, and faithfulness the belt around his loins.

⁶ The wolf shall live with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the kid, the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them.

⁷ The cow and the bear shall graze, their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

⁸ The nursing child shall play over the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put its hand on the adder's den.

⁹ They will not hurt or destroy on all my holy mountain; for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

¹⁰On that day the root of Jesse shall stand as a signal to the peoples; the nations shall inquire of him, and his dwelling shall be glorious.

⁴For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and by the encouragement of the scriptures we might have hope. ⁵ May the God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another, in accordance with Christ Jesus, ⁶ so that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

⁷ Welcome one another, therefore, just as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God. ⁸ For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the circumcised on behalf of the truth of God in order that he might confirm the promises given to the patriarchs, ⁹ and in order that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. As it is written, "Therefore I will confess^[a] you among the Gentiles, and sing praises to your name";

¹⁰ and again he says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people";

¹¹ and again, "Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and let all the peoples praise him"; ¹² and again Isaiah says, "The root of Jesse shall come, the one who rises to rule the Gentiles; in him the Gentiles shall hope." ¹³ May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

TRANSGRESSIONS FROM US


as a father pities his children,
