The Copper State Basketball Club has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct. The essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are the foundations of sportsmanship and are demonstrated by the core principles of respect, responsibility, fairness and good citizenship.

As a Copper State Basketball Club Parent, I will provide positive support, care and encouragement for each child participating in the Copper State Basketball Club by adhering to the following code of conduct.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support at all times.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not adults.
- I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games.
- I will not confront coaches or managers at any time during games.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games.
- If I have a concern regarding coaching or playing time, I will set up a separate meeting with the coaches outside of practices or after games.
- I will recognize that the Copper State Basketball Club competes at a different level of competition. Playing time is not guaranteed, it is earned.
- I will recognize that playing time is not necessarily equal among the players. It is determined on the needs of the team by the coaches.

Failure to follow these rules may result in your being asked to remove yourself from the area and possibly future events.
