miss you, love you, and wish I could be there with you----'so. I wrote.'




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




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MASTERING LIFE THROUGH THE POWER OF JESUS CHRIST---- IN PRISON

SUCCESSFUL MINISTRY

I recently sat with a group of college students from the North Carolina Field Ministry Program (NCFMP), listening to them discuss their final assignment for their final semester. The question they were to address was: What does successful prison ministry look like? As I listened to their responses, I heard theological personal philosophies answers and communicated in such academic ways that I almost forgot that I was sitting in prison with a bunch of inmates. Weeks passed by after that conversation, yet the question remained fixed in my mind, demanding an answer. So, I began to interview other students from the college, asking them what they thought success in prison ministry looks like. I received an overwhelming amount of response. Then, I interviewed James Benoy, Mr. MasterLife, who had the same assignment. James responded by handing me an index card that "Success is not determined by your read: accomplishments: success is determined by how bright Jesus shines in your accomplishments - when you fade into the shadows, and you are forgotten in the moment, and all eyes are on Jesus, then you are successful in ministry" James Benoy. James had given me a beautiful, well thought out response, but I still did not know what that looked like in prison, until Christmas 2021.

Christmas 2021 at Nash Correctional was filled with excitement, Christmas cheer, and Jesus. The men in 2B dorm began making plans, putting posters on the wall, and assigning duties to those who volunteered to help. At chow, I heard guys from other dorms discussing their own plans for a Christmas party in their dorm. And later, I learned that Christmas parties were being planned by inmates in almost every dorm at NCI – WOW!

Well, a couple of days before Christmas I was in the med line overhearing a big debate about who started the whole idea for these Christmas parties. You should have heard the inmate.com versions of the story. Of course, I knew the truth but didn't dare attempt to enter into the debate. Then it hit me – I could see what a successful prison ministry looks like in practice. So, I am writing this article to show you what the Lord has revealed to me.

For the past 15 years, Travis Mileur, President of MasterLife Ministry Inc, has committed his life to discipling, supporting, and collaborating with inmate James Benoy. In return, James utilized this training and support to do what he loves the most: serve the Lord Jesus Christ and show love to the convicts on the yard. As a result of Travis and James faithfulness, MasterLife Ministry Inc was birthed. This ministry has evolved into MasterLife Adopt-A-Life (AAL). Mastering Life After Prison (MAP), MasterLife Newsletter (MLNL), MasterLife Population Outreach Program (MPOP), MasterLife small groups, and the famous MasterLife Christmas party.

James excitedly tell me the story of how it all began in a small jail in Georgia where he began to head a small MasterLife group with a group of men who could not read. Within a few years it grew to include Bible Trivia, Sunday burritos services, and an annual Christmas part for the entire dorm. 5 years into his ministry, James was approved to hold MasterLife in the prison chapel, visitation room, and gym of every prison location he was housed at. Hundreds of men were attending ML programs; lives were being transformed and families restored. Many men began to start their own ML groups across the state prison system.

James eventually landed in the North Carolina Field Minister Program at NCI in 2017. This did not stop MLM. By the end of his freshman year at the College at Southeastern, James had begun facilitating Sunday burritos for the 80 men in the dorm, administrating Sunday services in the dorm, executing Nash Correctional first Christmas party, and organizing small ML discipleship groups in his dorm.

During his sophomore year, James and his classmates were moved to another dorm where he continued doing what the Lord called him to do – plant churches, administrate, execute outreach to the prison population, disciple men, and host ML Christmas parties.

By his Junior and Senior years, James" impact at NCI had grown throughout the entire facility. There were 8 ML groups in various dorms, Sunday services in 3 dorms, and inmate led Christmas parties in almost every dorm at NCI, - WOW!

Through all of this, James' MLM has never been featured in the NCI Nash News, has never made the paper, and has never been acknowledged by the College at Southeastern – so, no wonder many men don't know the origin of these events.

And, as this 5th year of Christmas events took place in the various dorms, I was in the dorm where I was able to observe James Benoy, Mr. MasterLife, as he sat in the back of the room, in the shadows, enjoying the Christmas party. James didn't facilitate, administrate, or communicate that he had any part in the event this year, yet it was his God-given vision that inspired so many others. I cannot help but look at this index card and the words coined by James Benoy truly apply to this man's heart: "Success is not determined by your accomplishments; success is determined by how bright Jesus shines in your accomplishments. When you fade into the shadows, and you are forgotten in the moment, and all eyes are on Jesus, then you are successful in ministry."

Long after Mr. MasterLife is gone from NCI and DPS, Jesus Christ will still shine through these Christmas parties.

That, my friend, is what successful Prison Ministry looks like!

First year of my walk with Christ, I met Travis Mileur, a man who was

in Prison Ministry. He discipled me through a program called Master Life Discipleship Program - written by Avery T. Willis, Jr., Southern Baptist Missionary, Pastor, President of Indonesia Baptist Theological Seminary, and later working for the Christian Development Division of the Sunday School Board for the Southern Baptist Convention. He taught me the foundational tools to stay rooted in Christ. But what impacted me the most is that after the program was over and we both moved on to other places. He kept in touch with me, encouraged me, and helped me get up when I was down. He never gave up on me. This man walked me from a Spiritual Child to a rooted and grounded Disciple of Jesus Christ. Travis sent books to me to help me in my studies; he blessed me with a monthly allowance to help with canteen items. He be-came a Spiritual Father to me. I was like Timothy⁽ⁱ⁾. Well, I was being blessed so much by all of this, that I would share coffee and oatmeal pies, etc. It felt good to help others. Not realizing that I was building relationships in the process. Then it happened!! Some of the guys I had been making friends with asked me if I would help them read the Bible (two of them could not read, I found out later). So, I brought some candy mints and coffee and we sat down and prayed and started in the Gospel of John. Later on, in my cell, The Holy Spirit began to remind me of the Disciple's Cross presentation from MasterLife class. The next day I began teaching. Since then, this little Bible study has grown into a ministry, called MasterLife Ministry, Inc; a ministry that over 1000 men have been discipled through. Travis is my teacher, my Spiritual Father, my co-laborer in ministry, my encourager but most of all, he is my friend. I have a New Future, a New Hope, a New Family – GOD gave it to me \bigcirc ! I am not in prison anymore; I am on the Mission Field. James Benoy

Hello, all MasterLife followers and disciples: It has been several months since the last time I wrote for the MasterLife Newsletter. I want to express the joy I receive when I read all your contributions to the ministry and newsletter!! Since the last time I contributed an article, my husband Andy and I dedicated ourselves to helping further the work of our Lord, by providing support through the *Adopt-A-Life* Program. Kirston Angell, who is a recent graduate of the *North Carolina Field Minister Program*, has displayed the fortitude that a field minister must possess, to minister for the Glory of the Kingdom of God.

I have been in the field of educating and providing encouragement to numerous youth who are residing in facilities for troubled teens. These youth have addiction, PTSD, sexual abuse, mental health, legal, criminal, violence, and several issues that they receive help with. Of all of the problems that these youth face, they deal with the problem of trust. They do not trust others or others do not trust them. Trust, when broken, is a difficult trait to regain, whether it is trusting others or gaining the trust of others. But God provides this message:

Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths". (NKJV: New King James Version)

Many in society do not trust inmates and do not entertain the thought of helping them. Andy and I have placed our trust in the Lord, and that Kirston Angell will receive our support and use it to minister to those who also need that trust, love and forgiveness. If God had not placed me in the position that I have been in, working with troubled youth, I may not be as "trusting" as I am right now. I have listened to them cry because they can't be trusted, or they can't trust anyone. However, there is hope in Christ Jesus, that trust can be returned, by allowing Him to direct your paths!!

My prayer is that God will work through Kirston's ministering to reach those who will receive His message of love, repentance, forgiveness, and TRUST in Him with their whole hearts.

The status of being a prisoner carries with it many negative connotations. Inmates are often viewed as evil, manipulative, violent, and selfish. In some cases, this rings true and many of the stigmas and stereotypes placed on the incarcerated are reinforced. However, there are some people who truly reach the end of themselves during their tenure behind these walls. For me, the end of myself came at the beginning of my relationship with Jesus Christ. When I believed the gospel message, Jesus began to work in my heart. The things I used to love and pursue---drugs, money, women, respect, and acknowledgement--began to fade away. As I continued to grow in Christ through discipleship groups like Master life, I learned that I wasn't just merely saved



from the penalty of my sins. Christ saved me by his grace in order to bring him glory and honor through my testimony, lifestyle, good works, and helping other understand God's word. While my heart, mind, morals, and values changed as I drew closer to Christ, my incarceration did not. Incarceration itself presents many obstacles, especially in developing reference to positive relationships, acquisition of resources like study bibles, dictionary's, discipleship books, correspondence courses, etc. My partnership with Mrs. Becky Keeter-Lee through the Adopt-a-Life program has led to a good friendship, mutual encouragement, and various levels of support. I just graduated from the North Carolina Field Minister program, and I am awaiting a transfer to Foothill's Correctional. While I don't know exactly what my job will entail, I know that my Adopt-a-Life partner has my back. Becky prays for me and offers encouragement by messaging on our tablet system. Becky also selflessly gives of her resources by placing funds in a ministry purposes account set up through Master life Inc. so that I will always have access to the study materials I need to provide for any bible studies or small discipleship groups that I lead. To be supported and trusted in such a way makes me feel valued as a human being. And for that, I say Thank you Becky. I am extremely grateful.

I HAVE LED A VERY PRIVILEDGED LIFE, AND HAVE SOME **EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES WHICH HAVE ENHANCED** MY LIFE AND UNDERSTANDING. AFTER GRADUATION FROM HIGH SCHOOL, I DEGREE RECEIVED Α B.S. IN HORTICULTURE SCIENCE. I WORKED IN THE LANDSCAPE/NURSER FIELD FOR SOME YEARS. AFTER A LIFE ALTERING SITUATION, I THOUGHT I SHOULD DO, OR AT LEAST TRY TO DO SOMETHING I HAD THOUGHT ABOUT AFTER GRADUATION HIGH SCHOOL. THAT WAS TO PREPARE MYSELF TO SERVE GOD. MY INITIAL THOUGTHS WERE TO BECOME A MISSIONARY ТО AFRICA. ALWAYS THOUGHT AFRICA WAS COOL! I THEN WENT AND RECEIVED A MASTER OF DIVINITY FROM SOUTHEASTERN BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY. FOLLOWING MY GRADUATION FROM THERE I FOUND A DPS CLINICAL CHAPLAINCY POSITION WHICH I FOLLOWED FOR NINE YEARS. I RESIGNED THAT POSITION IN 2013. ALWAYS MISSED MY CHAPLAINCY JOB, BUT THE THEN GOVERNOR DELETED CHAPLAINS AT ALL BUT THE CLOSE CUSTODY LEVEL INSTITUTIONS.

I HAVE REMAINED IN CONTACT WITH THE LEADER OF THE MASTERLIFE MINISTRY SINCE THAT TIME. I WANTED TO ENCOURAGE HIM AND I LIKED TO STAY CONNECTED. HE IS A VETERAN TO THE WORKINGS OF PRISON INSTUTIONS AND HAS SOME OF THE NEATEST IDEAS HOW TO REACH MEN AND ENCOURAGE THEM IN THEIR PURSUIT OF GOD THROUGH JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD. I'M JUST AS PROUD OF HIM AS IF HE WERE MY SON, AND HE IS A GO GETTER WHO PERHAPS NEEDS TO SLOW DOWN SOME, BUT I AM ENCOURAGED ΒY HIS CONSTANT ENTHUSIASM FOR THE MASTERLIFE PROGRAM.

I HAVE RECENTLY, THIS YEAR, BEGUN AN "ADOPT A LIFE" MISSION WITH A MOST INTELLEGENT MAN WHO HAS A GREAT PASSION FOR THE STATE OF MEN'S SALVIFIC SATE AND HAS COMPLETED THE SOUTHEASTERN SEMINARY COURSE INSTITUTED AT NASH CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION. WITH WHOM I AM VERY IMPRESSED. HAVEN'T MET HIM YET BUT CORRESPOND WITH HIM. I TOLD HIM THAT I'M CLAIMING ONE HALF (1/2) OF THE LIVES HE DIRECTS TO THE LORD. HA HA, BUT I AM SERIOUS. I HAVE SUCH GREAT EXPECTATIONS FOR HIM, AND FEEL HE IS MOST CAPABLE THROUGH THE GIFTS GOD HAS GIVEN HIM. IT IS A WONDERFUL OPPORTUNITY FOR ME AS WELL. I GET ENCOURAGED, AND DO SO WANT TO KEEP HIM ENCOURAGED AND GROWING. I ALSO WANT TO HELP HIM IN HIS PERSONAL GROWTH, FOR I AM CONVINCED THE MORE HONEST WE ARE WITH OURSELVES, THE GREATER OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE LORD MAY GROW.

I AM HOPEFUL AND PRAYING FOR GOD TO LIFT OTHERS UP WHO HAVE SO MUCH TO SHARE, THAT THEY TOO MAY GET INVOLVED WITH THE LIVES OF INCARCERATED MEN TO ENCOURAGE THEM WITH THEIR GOD GIVEN GIFTS OF ENCOURAGEMENT AND FAITH, TO HELP SOMEONE WHO OTHERWISE FEELS LONELY TO GET CONNECTED TO ONE IN THE CHRISTIAN FAITH.

I use not these words for mere flattery of

conscience but because our Lord Jesus has performed an amazing work in my life. I attended one of the roughest elementary schools in Durham, North Carolina while raised in one of the most abusive environments. I lived in a continuation of fear and joy. Then, due to my artistic ability that was refined under the pressures of home, school, and life I was chosen to attend one of the most prestigious middle-high schools in Durham – Durham School of the Arts. This was a school of extreme diversity. Here God poured into my life, skills of computer graphics and art design, pottery, photography, piano, guitar, theatre, singing and the list goes on. Then my heart died – my grandmother, she was my inspiration and motivation. When she died, I died. I dropped out of school with a year remaining. I began to live a life cultured by the streets of my city. From gang affiliation, to drugs, selling drugs, unfaithful and abusive relationships, selling women via prostitution, buying sexual favors, alcohol, addiction to pornography etc.

For 17 years my life, as many say, was a roller coaster ride of ups and downs. Being molested by my aunt and brother, placing myself in the system of foster care and group homes, to homelessness and beyond. This is only the tip of the iceberg. BUT GOD!!! Finally became all the way involved more than ever before because I'd hit my perceived rock bottom that landed me in Durham's County Jail, and I cried all the way out in complete surrender. Ever since that day, October 22, 2015, our Savior appointed me and chose me to His ministry as a pastor. At that time in life, I had no idea what that truly meant, but His Spirit fell upon me strongly giving me desires and a zeal to do in a way greater than the desire or zeal I had to live the life I was living. I started preparing songs and sermons for service as God used me to be a fisher of men in that county jail and throughout my incarceration.

Today, after seven long years, I'm ordained as a pastor. Right after my ordination at Harnett Correctional Institution where I eventually met Bro. James Benoy and he introduced me to the ministry he, Bro. Travis, and his family established, which is the full work of God, MasterLife Ministry Inc.. I began to sit in on his sessions to see what God was doing with him in and through this ministry. I experienced a great work of God through these sessions for the oppressed in chains, so I in support of my brothers ministry and Jesus's Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20), committed myself as a partner and co-laborer of MasterLife's mission in raising up leaders and sincere, genuine followers of Jesus Christ and not mere fanatics of Jesus. training them up, getting involved, and unconditionally as well as sacrificially loving them as they go through their individual sanctification processes like a farmer who plants a seed and patiently endures as he waits for the harvest of his labor and toil. Blood, sweat, and tears I'm willing to give to each of these men regardless to how challenging it gets. Jesus was patient with me for 30 years, I can at least be patient with those in whom I've been entrusted to shepherd.

Being a MasterLife Minister over my own group has been exciting in every way. From opening up with letting my family know how much I love them, to sharing what we are thankful for daily, opening up in prayer or conversational prayer, ice-breaker questions for building and bonding, memorization of scripture, working through the MasterLife books by Avery T. Willis, working through one another's personal or ideological strongholds, and so forth. My focus and goal as a minster for MasterLife is pointing these men to Jesus and encouraging them to STAND and CONTINUE in the FAITH no matter what life throws their way. Staying faithful to Christ and the family of believers.

In the process of doing this and being faithful as Jesus has taught me, our brother in Christ, James Benoy, has

introduced me to Bro. J.D. (Jon Daniels) and Bro. Tony (Pastor) of Bayshore Community Church. Me, along with my group of 10, want to extend our thanks to you not only adopting my life, but theirs as well. Bayshore, before I ever knew you would become a part of my life, I praved that you would. I always earnestly pray that GOD will place those in my life that need to be so that I may fulfill His will in my life and to immediately remove those who don't need to be unless they are intended as a learning curve. I've prayed for you and our brothers and sisters throughout the world daily, for your comfort, protection, provision, guidance, your purpose being fulfilled, and Holy Spirit empowered lives. I truly love you for loving me not even knowing me. Because of MasterLife, the scripture becomes a reality. "Now it is requirsed that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful". (1 Cor. 4:2) and "from everyone who has been given much, much will be required, and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked". (Luke 12:48) Jesus has called for my life that He may lift it up, so shall it be given, so shall it be raised by Him. Finally....after all of those years locked up, I get to write an article for the Mastering-life After Prison (MAP) section of the ML Newsletter. I used to

lay on my bunk and dream about this article:-) And now I pray for the day that you are out here Mastering-life [through the power of Jesus Christ] After Prison. Mastering life through the power of Jesus Christ in prison or after prison can be tricky. I like to compare it to driving down the road in a heavy snowstorm: you think you are being cautious enough, going slow enough, staying alert enough, then you hit an ice-covered section of highway, and whoooooh!!! At times like these you remember that you have no control: it does no good to hit the brakes, the gas, or try to steer the wheel; all you do is start praying....Jeeeeeesuuuuuuus!

Before I tell you my Mastering-life After Prison story, I feel that it is important to begin with my Mastering-life in Prison story:

First of all, when I hit the yard at Caledonia Correctional, serving God wasn't even on my radar; I was "going hard on the yard!" I served my time on the ball court, bangin', fighting, hustling, and getting high. My selfish, narcissistic, survival instincts had driven my entire family out of my life, but served me well in prison---I fit right in. But secretly I was one miserable dude who wanted to be a

different person. I just understood that prison is not the place to be getting soft. Then I began to notice these MasterLife guys everywhere I turned. They were like a gang of happy-dudes; always smiling, hanging out together, and looking out for one another. Some of them would speak to me and invite me to the Master Life Program they had in the gym. Then I heard they had free writing supplies, free hygiene items, and all-you-can-eat free chicken & pizza party at the end! Then one of the Homeys from my set told me that if you can get close to that Benoy guy, you'll be straight, because he's got money and he looks out! I thought to myself, this is my meal ticket; I'm going to infiltrate this program, get in good with Benoy, and ride out my time. Being the narcissistic and self-confident person that I am, utilizing the masterminded skills that I have, being well versed in scripture as well as the 48 laws of power, my plans would be easily executed. So, I signed up for Master Life, and here is what happened that forever changed my life: During the first MasterLife meeting, Benoy was the speaker, giving an introduction to ML speech. Somewhere in the speech he began to prophesy, saying something like, "God wants to do something in your life, He wants to reveal Himself to you, but you won't get real...you won't lay down your old life and allow him in." Benoy said, "if you will make a decision that you are going to put your life in hold, separate from the yard, erase everything that you think about Christianity & jailhouse religion, and open your heart & apply the principles of this program, I promise you on the authority of the Word of God that Jesus Christ will manifest Himself to you in a very real way." But, you have to ask Him, you have to seek Him, you have to look for Him to show up. What does that loo like? Simple: say, "Lord, I need to know if you are real, show me!" Then, obey Him. What does that look like? For now, you have obeyed Him by being here. and for the next fourteen weeks, the men of God in this MasterLife will teach you principle that you will apply to your life--- that is obeying Him. So, how does He reveal Himself to you? It is different for everyone, but God knows what to do in YOUR life for you to see Him. For some of you, God will show up through a letter in the mail from someone; for others He will show up through some need being met; somebody will get reconnected with a loved one that you haven't heard from in years; for some it will be something as simple as a cup of coffee from a stranger. But, you have to look for Him. And when you see Him, tell somebody!" Benoy said, "don't you want to know if this Jesus thing

is real? don't you deserve to know the truth? I challenge you to settle this matter once and for all!" Now I might not have preached that exactly the way Benoy did, but, all I know is I prayed right then and told God that I was going to give Him all,; but I really needed Him to show up---and show up he did!!!

Before I proceed to tell you what happened next, I need to say: by no means am I preaching that God is a genie in a bottle. However, I do believe that God blesses people in similar ways that fathers give gifts to their children---little kids get candy and toys, older children get things they need like socks and shoes, and still grownups get to work and raise other children. With that said, God blessed me with candy:-)

When I left that MasterLife class and was called to the unit mangers office. When I got there, Unit manager Jones handed me a piece of paper that had a name and phone number on it---I broke down and wept---it was my dad! I hadn't heard from him in over a decade. I began to thank God! I remembered what I had just prayed less than 30 minutes ago in ML class. And I realized that God showed up. After leaving Jones' office, I went to find Benoy and tell him what had happened; that he had just prophesied this. He smiled and said, "God's always doing that kind of stuff, and he'll keep on doing it for those whose hearts are fully committed to Him, who will thank Him and brag about Him." And brothers, I have continued to do just that...and He has continued to pour out blessing after blessing in my life. And The Lord gave me the power to MasterLife in prison: He delivered me from the gang life, hustling, getting high, conning, and lying: He made a way for me to move in the block with Benoy, completed the 24week ML workbook series. I joined the choir, became a ML-Minister, wrote my own ML material, became a chapel clerk, and began to mentor other inmates--- God showed up at every turn!!! Then I was released...

With this comparison, I want to be clear that practically there is a huge difference in Mastering life in prison and mastering life after prison; and as I tell my story, I will explain: While Mastering life in Prison, one is immediately and daily surrounded by the encouragement, accountability, and love of Christian brothers. From the time I got up in the morning to the time I went to bed, everywhere I turned, there was a brother: in the dorm, on the yard, in the chow hall, four times a week at church, and five days a week in my MasterLife group! That kind of brotherhood fosters strength. On top of that, in prison you become significant to others very quickly: In other words, God gives you purpose as He begins to involve you in His mission. For me, it seemed like overnight I went from hustling, fighting, bangin', and ballin', convict; to bornagain, Holy Ghost-filled, choir member, chapel clerk, and MasterLife-minister who was writing my own MasterLife material!! So, as a Christian in prison, I went from a nobody, going nowhere, to a somebody, going somewhere. Christ provides this type of transformed life.

Then, overnight, I got thrown into this great big free world---and no matter how much I prepared, how cautious I was, how slowly I tried to transition, I went from what seemed like a somebody back to a nobody. Like Cinderella when the clock struck midnight and she went back home, I was just another ex-felon alone in a big, nasty, hostile world. I was trying to navigate the storms of life with no Christian encouragement or accountability, and no Christian purpose to focus on. But, I, thank God for the six biblical disciplines l learned in MasterLife, disciplines that I had appropriated into my daily life. I also thank Him for the follow up support of the MLM, Inc brothers like Travis, Benoy, and Walter. These brothers collectively and separately played major parts in helping me navigate through the slippery parts of mastering life after prison. Walter walked me to the door of my release preparing my mind for the things to come, things that he recently experienced. Benoy reminded me of some crucial principle that we learned from Katie Sousa's book, "Key to your Expected End." this is important, so let me detour for a minute to instill this into you all: One of the biggest phenomenon within the penal system concerning jailhouse religion goes like this: "how is it that people go to prison, get on fire for God, and get out only to return to the same old lifestyle?" This phenomenon is the reason so many people scoff at jailhouse Christians. But the solution to this phenomenon has been discovered by Souza and practiced by the Master Life brothers who are now out and mastering life through the power of Jesus Christ. The solution lies within "God's purpose." God has a calling for every believer's life: a call to salvation, a call to service, and a call to a specific purpose. The reason people get on fire for the Lord in prison is because they answered the call to salvation and are experiencing the blessedness that comes with cultivating that relationship with the Lord Jesus and His body the church. Then they begin to serve the church inside the

prison through the choir, chapel clerk, or vard ministry. But they never find their purpose; or if they do have an idea of their purpose, they never make the connection as to how it fits in with their release plans. So, they transition back into society assuming that somehow they will stumble into God's purpose and plan for their lives.... WRONG!!! Instead, what tends to happen is the world sucks them right back into its claws...they are driving along the road of life, and a curve in the road has an ice-slick. They hit it and slide right over the cliff. They wake up and find themselves back in jail and everybody echoes those famous words, "I knew that jailhouse religion wasn't real!" What happened? no purpose!!! brothers you have to have a ministry plan, goal, purpose!!! you've got to be surrounded by a network of believer's who have "been there and done that!"

When I got out, Benoy reminded me of this truth! He kept hammering me with the six biblical disciplines of discipleship: which he summarizes as, "quiet time and service!" Kevin, he would say, you must continue you quiet time and you must continue to minister to others!" That's the key to Mastering Life After Prison! Then he'd say, "don't worry, we're gonna put you to work until the Lord gives you clear direction!" Travis sent me some business cards with my ministry title on it, I began mentoring a young man who will might someday be my business partner and ministry partner,; I'm answering phone calls from prisoners, I'm supporting other ML brothers through Adopt-A-Life program; and, I'm praying and laying plans for my upcoming electrical company that will employ men from the upcoming "Mastering Life After Prison Home!" "The MAP Home!" Which will be a transitional home for brother being released who wish to MasterLife After prison.

(Thanks brother Jesse and Benoy). Besides all of this, The Lord has blessed me with a home, a truck, a BMW, and a job making six figures! I tell you that not to brag, but to show you what the Lord can do with an ex-con who turns his life over to Him while in prison. I tell you that in hopes that you too will use your time

to learn a trade, get in a Master Life group, and surrender all to the Lord Jesus Christ. There is something fulfilling in serving Jesus, the one who took my place on the cross; and it's an awesome feeling to serve others who have been where I've been. And, although I'm still travelling with caution, I'm able to see the road ahead, the storms are getting lighter to bear, and as the true Master of Life is behind the wheel, I am able to enjoy the ride.

I will close by sharing that through MLM's MAP strategy, the Lord is showing me how my work life and home life are able to be interwoven in with the ministry that He has called me into. It is exciting to watch as He directs my steps, builds my life, and simultaneously uses me in the lives of others.

NEW BEGININGS JON DANIEL MAP PART #1

My name is Jon Daniel. Some of you know me personally as I sat where you now sit for over 6 years in North Carolina DPS. My stay there was nothing special in events other than my involvement in Master Life. I entered prison having lost everything in life both socially and financially. All relationships were gone I was alone. If there was ever a time in life where I had no options this was it. My faith in God was nonexistent and in many ways, I was skeptical of His even caring for me. I walked the yard you now occupy with little to no care in my life ever being a success again. I came across Master Life at AMCI. I began to attend a morning group and work on letting God remove things that were in the way. I carried tremendous hatred for many events and people in life. This made it very hard for my heart to get right. God began to work on the small things in my life that I was willing to let go. Staying focused on God was tough for me since I was used to being self-reliant. In many steps forward God revealed the person He wanted me to be. Was I ready for this then? No. It took coming back to finish my post release for me to give up my grip on how I wanted to do things.

I was released in March 4, 2018, almost two years ago and will never be back. It was good to finish the sentence. More than that it was good to leave prison with no real expectation of what I was going to do. I went straight to the train station waited 24 hours for the next train to Florida. When I got to Sarasota, I had 25 dollars or less in my pocket. I entered a homeless shelter where I slept on the floor for 12 dollars a night. Taking it real slow I worked day labor jobs flagging traffic and stuff like that. I was helped by a Jewish group who assisted me in a deposit for an apartment and in late May I moved into an apartment. I just kept working and trusting that Gods got a plan. A week after moving



I began working my current job. I had no furniture, or dishes just a bed. I spent nights on the bed praying for God to do what he does best and change my situation.

During the summer God began putting people and things into my life that were good. In this summer I met my now wife Connie who is the best woman in the world for me. She has all the attributes that I need to have a great marriage with her. God knows who I am. He's got this. Connie brings with her a caring and loving warmth, and it fills our marriage with security and respect. God could have given me any woman, but he chose Connie to walk with me and share to ups and downs of life.

There have been many financial blessings God has given me also. He has put an employer who is a Christian in my life. This person is a mentor who genuinely cares about my success and invests time in my life in areas not related to work. This job has given me financial means to bless others and my family in ways that are His. I truly have no financial worries most of the time. More signs of His plan.

In the environment you are now in many would say you can never have a good job again. You will never be financially capable again. God doesn't care. Your life is worthless. I live today a living proof that Gods got plans I never thought would happen in my life. Tomorrow Connie and I will have a contract secured on our first home. I NEVER thought this would happen in my life. I just thought I would have to put all of this in somebody else's name. Truth be told I qualified without my wife in less than two years removed from prison with \$25.00 as my starting point. God can do anything. I believe he enjoys doing things we think are unachievable.

This Christmas I want you to know God has a plan. I'm nobody special I'm just me. In Gods eyes I am His and he controls it all if I allow Him to. There is no bigger fan of you than God. He is pulling every step of the way for you to do the right thing. He is cheering for you to get back up when you fall. He is your advocate and protector. He loves you. As you read this sitting on your bunk today rest assured your road has not ended. There are always paths yet untaken and plans unfulfilled. While you await the next step trust that God wants you to have a great life there and elsewhere. In my life God began giving me the small stuff to see how I would handle it. So, this is the best place to begin. Am I handling the small stuff God has placed in my life? Am I doing the next right thing? This could be as simple as a soup to the guy who is hungry and has nobody to help him 2 bunks down from you.

It is mine and Connie's hope that this Christmas begins with a trust in God for your life. He's got your best interest in mind, and He has a plan for you. It begins with the small stuff and moves to a greater fulfillment. Today Gods waiting on you. Always remember you are Gods choice. Chosen by Him. God cannot fail nor is He forgetful. He knows your wants and needs. He loves you. Merry Christmas!!

My apologies as I am so very behind in getting you an update of all God is doing down here in Bradenton Florida. I write you today from a very different place than I would have expected. So, lets title this Gods Will. As I encounter my day-to-day life its very unclear in each event what is the right path for me to take when making decisions. Now I am not speaking about right and wrong paths but maybe just the simple question of does God want me to take this road or another.

In the past two months Connie and I have taken some really life changing directions. It all really started from a bunch of bad decisions on my part relative to finances and taking on debt that I really didn't need to help family members and people out of situations they could not fix. These decisions while good ones cause a bunch of hardship on our finances, and we began to seek a better remedy to repay the debt. I went to my bank and was in the process of borrowing against the house we rebuilt after the fire. In this process I started getting home offers that were what we would consider insane, and we sold the house. God will?

So there is a bunch here to unpack. I would say that we always look at the situation from what has happened rather than knowing what the plan is. This is very easy to do because we don't have the foresight of knowing the outcome. Look when the house caught fire and we rebuilt it we looked at this as a blessing from God for us to have a newly rebuilt home and it was. 14 months later the

home is now owned by another family from Canada who are believers, have 8 adopted kids and we have a good friendship with them. I am the guy helping them while they make the eventual transition by having the grass mowed and moving stuff in since they are not here. But guys here is what Connie and I finally got out of this. God was rebuilding our home for them. We are just as blessed in the situation. We just have a different role in the process. Sometimes we are not hands but feet. Does this make any sense to you? Guess what for the first time I think in my life I saw this unfold and understood as we made the decision to sell that God had a different plan.

What's the message here don't hold on to situations longer

than God wants you to. If you truly think God has got everything than take good steps. Do what might seem uncomfortable, follow where led. Sometimes taking these steps will cause us to see the blessing for us in a situation was short term and by moving on God has a different one. Connie and I now have the blessing of being financially independent. We owe nothing and have been able to bless others in the process. Guys this is just the beginning. Remember it's been under 52 months since I was with you right there at count time. I could not have asked for God for the things that I have. Never in my plan was this the road. Truthfully I can say I would have never asked to be blessed as I am today.

My message to each of you is this. There are many roads to Gods plan in your life. It's called restoration. You can make wrong decisions about right things and God will work it out for His glory. I hope this finds you in a place of peace in your life. It's not the easiest place to be so my prayer this morning is for each of you to find your road. I want to pray for you, your families, relationships, challenges you face. May you begin to understand the place God has for you today just where you are. I pray you come to an understanding that tomorrow is already taken care of. May God continue the work he has begun in you, and I pray most of all for you to remain strong, protected and loved!
