Well, our summer is nearly over, and fall is upon us. What a beautiful time of year it is. Summer is beautiful with everything being green and blossoming and growing but fall is the culmination of all the colors of everything trying to produce the fruits of the seeds that were planted. Whether they were planted or grew from seeds naturally. We as humans are so very blessed that we are included in this wonderful system that we call our earth.

Everything from plants and animals to humans that complete the cycle every year after year. We are so busy hustling from one thing to another and one place to another, we forget the saying, "take time to smell the roses". I just had another birthday the other day and we take it for granted most of the time, but it makes me sad when I realize how old I am and I think of my friends, fellow soldiers that their lives ceased so many years ago. It was 60 years ago in September that I believed that I would not see my 21st birthday. I was in the Republic of South Vietnam in 1964, and the French had just been driven out 10 short years before that. I was a Huey helicopter Crew chief/Door Gunner and had flown hundreds of combat missions, got shot up pretty bad and 17 bullet holes later we hit the ground. My crew was lucky as we all got out alive and lived to fly another day or I should say many more days.

Lots of young soldiers, pilots and crew members were lost in those many years that the United States stayed and helped the South Vietnamese try to keep from being turned to communism. I to this day have a very hard time as I do believe all the surviving soldiers, sailors, airman of all the wars and conflicts from around the world since the beginning of time ponder why and how we survived. I guess we are not meant to understand as that was decided by a higher power. I do remember times when I was scared as can be, but I can't remember being scared to die. We all stood in front of the flag of our great country and swore to protect and serve up to and including giving our lives for this country. I worry today about all the people that enjoy the benefits of living here and never consider serving this country in any job or
