|---------------------------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Andirons *                | large fire-dogs, often with hooks for a spit                                        |
| Apparell                  | apparel: clothes                                                                    |
| Balance *                 | Scales: a beam for weighing large items                                             |
| Bed *                     | mattress, stuffed with feathers, flock or straw                                     |
| Bedstead                  | bedstead: wooden bed frame                                                          |
| Broche *                  | spit for roasting meat                                                              |
| Carpet                    | woven cloth cover to go on a table or bed rather than the floor                     |
| Caudron *                 | cauldron : large looking pot                                                        |
| Chaffer / Chaffing dish * | chafing-dish: a dish to keep food warm with a container for hot charcoal underneath |
| Charger                   | serving dish                                                                        |
| Coffer *                  | storage chest                                                                       |
| Cowle                     | cooling pail for milk                                                               |
| Ewre *                    | ewer : water jug                                                                    |
| Fetherbed                 | mattress filled with feathers                                                       |
| Flock                     | wool stuffing                                                                       |
| Flockebede                | mattress filled with odds and ends of wool                                          |
| Forme                     | bench                                                                               |
| Grid-iron                 | iron grill for grilling meat over a fire                                            |
| Latine                    | latten: metal like brass                                                            |
| Laver *                   | washing basin or sink                                                               |
| Pewter                    | Metal (tin & lead) used for plates & dishes (pieces) and tankards (pots)            |
| Pillowberes               | pillow cases                                                                        |
| Pothooke *                | S-shaped hook for hanging a cooking pot from a chain                                |
| Querne *                  | a grindstone for grinding corn by hand                                              |
| Sallets                   | salts, salt cellars                                                                 |
| Sestorne *                | cistern: a large jug with a tap                                                     |
| Tableboord *              | table-top, resting on a frame or trestles                                           |
| Tourne *                  | turn: spinning-wheel                                                                |
