| Harrowe         | A frame pulled over the earth after sowing corn             |
| Heiffer         | young cow                                                   |
| Iron-band       | iron-rimmed (wheels)                                        |
| Praisers        | valuers                                                     |
| Severalls       | Severals: enclosed fields, separate from large, open fields |
| Stock (of bees) | hive                                                        |
| Stringes        | reins                                                       |
| Vallowe         | Fallow: ground used for grazing                             |
| Yoke            | A wooden frame joining two oxen to pull a plough            |
