

#### First 7 Days: Fresh Coating Care

- A new coating needs time to fully cure. During this period:
- Avoid washing the vehicle.
- Do not apply waxes, sealants, or quick detailers.
- If the surface gets bird poo wet a piece of kitchen roll with warm water, put that on the bird poo and let it soak for 10 minutes then wipe away

#### Washing Routine (After Cure Period)

- Regular, gentle washing keeps the coating healthy and hydrophobic.
- Best washing method use the two-bucket method.
- Use a pH-neutral shampoo designed for coated vehicles.
- Wash from top to bottom using a soft wash mitt, not sponge
- Rinse thoroughly and dry with a plush microfiber towel or a blower.

## Avoid

- Automatic car washes with brushes.
- Roadside car washes due to strong chemicals many use and also dirty water
- Household detergents or strong degreasers.
- Dirty sponges or towels that can cause micro-scratches.

## General Help & Tips

- Ceramic coatings are resistant but not immune to water spotting.
- Always dry the vehicle after washing.
- If water spots appear, use a coating-safe water spot remover.
- Avoid washing in direct sunlight.
- Avoid snow foams in the sun
- When washing your car i suggest this as the bare minimum, wash bucket with grit guard, use a microfibre drying towel, PH neutral shampoo and a wash mitt. I can supply all if this helps.

## Maintenance

- Every 3–6 months
- Use a ceramic-safe topper or maintenance spray to boost gloss and hydrophobicity.

## Things That Damage Ceramic Coatings

- Abrasive polishes or compounds unless professionally advised..
- Harsh chemicals like all purpose cleaners, acids, or solvent-based cleaners on paintwork.
- Parking under trees for long periods (sap, pollen, bird droppings).
