

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF STAY

Tangalooma Life | 16 Triton Street, Moreton Island QLD 4025.



Functions / Parties / Events

Functions, Parties or Events are **not allowed** at Tangalooma Life. Tangalooma Life has a maximum occupancy of six guests. This includes visitors who are not staying overnight. This is to stop any events or parties taking place at the property larger than its maximum occupancy of six guests.

Noise and Conduct

The resort has 24hr security patrols and has a very strict 'Noise and Conduct' policy. All registered guests and non-registered guests (visitors) must adhere to the noise and conduct guidelines set out below without exception.

The person(s) making the reservation and/or the registered person(s) are responsible for the orderly conduct of their guests.

- A maximum of 6 guests are allowed on the premises.
- Keep noise to a minimum after 10pm and before 7am
- All vehicles must be parked on site and not on the road.
- Keep the premises and grounds clean and tidy.
- Any breakages must be reported, charges may apply
- Tangalooma Life is a non-smoking residence
- No Pets Allowed

A penalty charge of at least \$250 AUD will apply if Tangalooma Life deems the premises and grounds have not been left in a reasonable state of cleanliness upon departure or the terms of this agreement have been breached.

Should Tangalooma Life or Tangalooma Island Resort believe the conduct of the registered person(s) and their guests may affect the smooth running of their business, security or reputation, it reserves the right to terminate their stay and require the registered person(s) and their guests to remove their belongings and vacate the premises and resort with immediate effect.

Damage

Any damage caused to Tangalooma Life or Tangalooma Island Resort property including but not limited to: fittings, fixtures, vehicles and infrastructure during the stay by the person(s) registered or guests of the person(s) registered is the financial responsibility of the person(s) registered and charges may apply.

Tangalooma Life and Tangalooma Island Resort does not accept responsibility for the damage and safe keeping of any goods or personal property brought onto the premises or resort before, during or after the stay. It is the responsibility of the guest to arrange adequate insurance to cover such items.

Resort Buggy

Resort buggy use is subject to the damage clause above, strict driving rules, a valid driving licence and the acceptance of an activity waiver by a sole designated 25+ year old driver.
