#### Welcome back to Poojari:

As you may have already known, our poojari's (Shri. Dharmeshbhai Pandya) has successfully got his visa and again joined our samaj and started his duties since the evening of 11<sup>th</sup> August 2018. We're happy to welcome him back to our Samaj.

<u>GDPR:</u> Thanks to those who have already provided your GDPR consent (via email/paper form). As per the new legislation, BHS requires the members' consent to send out general communications (e.g. events, newsletters etc.). So, for those who haven't yet provided your consent, please ensure that each & every adult member in your family provide their consent ASAP to keep receiving the general communications from BHS.

I understand that a few of those who have provided their appropriate consent, have reported about not receiving the communications (by email) from BHS. I have ensured & doubly checked that those email addresses are part of the relevant BHS Communications list and that the emails are indeed sent to those addresses as well. So, if you still are unable to receive the regular updates, newsletters etc. via email, please ensure that you have the appropriate settings in your mailbox (as some of the options/settings may automatically place such emails in the junk/spam or even could mark it for deletion).

Further on this topic, I have come across the following instances with regards to some of the GDPR Consent forms received so far:

- **1. Duplicate form submissions**: Kindly ensure that if you've already submitted the consent by email or in paper form, please DO NOT submit the form again as it causes confusion (unless it's a change in your GDPR communication options in which case please mention it explicitly).
- **2. Not enough details provided:** Some have chosen the email option but haven't provided their email address. Also, many haven't provided their membership numbers, which then proves a difficult task in

**3. Using different surname at various instances:** If your surname has changed, please notify it separately to BHS, so that the latest details can be reflected in our records. With respect to GDPR, I notice that there are instances where there's a surname in BHS records & a different one being used in GDPR consent forms, which results in confusion & sometimes an unnecessary delay in capturing the consent (thereby causing a delay in adding the relevant member to the BHS Communications list).

The above are possible reasons why some members may not be receiving communications from BHS. So, if you have any concerns/issues please send an email to bharathindusamajpbo@gmail.com OR speak to one of the committee members present at the mandir.

BHS Membership 2018 - 2019: Those who would like to join or renew your membership, please note that it will be £15/- per adult ONLY until Sunday, 7th October 2018. As per standard practice, the Membership Fee will be £20/- per adult from Monday, 8th October 2018 onwards for the current membership calendar year.

#### BHS Membership Card for Navratri Event @ The Cresset:

You may be aware that the Entry for the Navratri Event at The Cresset is Free for BHS Members Only. So, as proof of membership, its mandatory that you produce a valid membership card (for the CURRENT MEMBERSHIP YEAR 2018 -19, its RED in Colour) upon entry, to the volunteers. In case if you are unable to produce the current membership card, you may be treated as a Guest, which means there'll be a £5/entry fee per person. It's therefore requested that you make sure that you have the current membership card available with you before entering the event. In case, you are a member for the current membership year (2018-19) but don't have the membership card (OR) have lost it, kindly contact the BHS Committee via email (bharathindusamajpbo@gmail.com) or in person ASAP.

Also, KINDLY NOTE that ONLY the Membership Number starting with '18XXX' will be accepted as a valid membership card.
