OFFICIAL NOTICE

By registering and participating in the Fish N' Flo Fishing Tournament, all participants agree to abide by the following rules and regulations. Rules are subject to change at the Captain's Meeting.

I. REGISTRATION & ENTRY

1. Entry Fee (Per Boat): Early Bird: \$300 per boat. Includes up to 4 anglers and 4 dinner tickets.
2. Additional Anglers: \$75 per additional angler (includes dinner and swag).
3. Payment & Confirmation: Registration is confirmed upon full payment. No entries will be held without payment.

II. IMPORTANT DATES & TIMES

4. Captain's Meeting: Pirate's Cove Marina, June 19, 2026, 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM. One representative per boat must attend.
5. Tournament Fishing Hours: June 20, 2026. Lines In: 6:00 AM. Lines Out: 3:00 PM.
6. Weigh-In: 12:00 PM – 5:00 PM. All fish must be weighed by 5:00 PM.

III. BOAT & ANGLER RULES

7. Maximum 4 anglers per boat unless additional anglers are purchased.
8. Rod and reel only. Electric reels allowed only for swordfish.
9. Maximum of 6 lines in the water per boat.

IV. FISHING RULES

10. Fishing limited to U.S. territorial waters.
11. Eligible species: Snook (Catch and Release), Mahi-Mahi, Kingfish, Wahoo.
12. Additional species: Amberjack.
13. Categories: Female Angler and Junior Angler.
14. Optional \$100 category entry required before fishing.

V. CATCH & WEIGH-IN RULES

15. Fish must comply with Florida and Federal regulations.
16. Snook requires photo or video verification.

17. One fish per species per angler.
18. Ties decided by earliest weigh-in time.

VI. SAFETY & COMPLIANCE

19. All boats must have VHF radio and monitor Channel 68.
20. Valid Florida saltwater fishing license required.
21. Captains responsible for crew. Fish at your own risk.

VII. WEATHER POLICY

22. Tournament may be delayed or canceled due to unsafe weather.
23. If canceled, proceeds may be retained or applied to a rescheduled event.

VIII. CONDUCT & DISQUALIFICATION

24. Officials may refuse entry or disqualify participants.
25. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification.

IX. AWARDS & PAYOUTS

26. Prizes based on participation, entry pools, and sponsorships.
27. Categories include species, female, junior, and additional entries.

X. MEDIA RELEASE

28. Participants grant permission for filming and promotional use without compensation.
