



## Safety When Traveling

LORD GOD Almighty, I bow before You with gratitude and reverence, acknowledging You as my Protector, my Guide, and the One who holds my life and all of creation in Your hands. Today, LORD, I seek Your divine covering and guidance as I prepare to travel. Whether I journey by foot, car, train, air, or any other mode of transportation, I ask that Your presence go before me, behind me, and all around me. I lift up not only my own travels but also those of my loved ones. Watch over every step we take and keep us in Your perfect peace.

LORD, I cannot deny that the recent news reports of accidents, crashes, and tragedies weigh heavily on my heart. My mind wrestles with anxiety, but I choose to submit these fears to You because I know that You are greater than anything I face. Your Word reminds me in Isaiah 41:10, “So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your GOD. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.” LORD, strengthen my heart and steady my mind. Teach me to lean into Your peace, trusting that You are my refuge and fortress, my GOD in whom I trust (Psalm 91:2).

Father, I ask for Your peace to flood my spirit. Philippians 4:6-7 teaches me to bring my anxieties to You, and so I pour out every worry. Cover me with the peace that surpasses all understanding. I know that You are my Keeper, the One who neither slumbers nor sleeps (Psalm 121:4). Remind me that no matter how uncertain the world may seem, You are always in control. Your plans for me are good, plans to give me a hope and a future (Jeremiah 29:11).

LORD, I ask for Your divine wisdom and discernment as I prepare for this journey. Your Word says in Proverbs 3:5-6 to trust in You with all my heart and lean not on my own understanding, but in all my ways submit to You, and You will make my paths straight. Help me to listen for Your still, small voice guiding me. If there is any danger ahead, if there is any reason I should delay or change my plans, I pray that You would make it abundantly clear. Let me never be in the wrong place at the wrong time. Guard me from distractions and impatience, and help me to trust in Your timing above my own.

LORD, I pray for Your divine protection over every aspect of this journey. Your Word says in Psalm 91:11, “For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.” I ask for angelic protection over me, my loved ones, and everyone traveling with us or around us. Station Your angels around our vehicles, planes, and paths to shield us from harm. I declare Psalm 121:7-8 over my life and the lives of my loved ones: “The LORD will keep you from all harm—He will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.”





LORD, I also pray for the operators of any vehicle, plane, or form of transportation I may use. Grant them alertness, focus, and skill to perform their duties with excellence. Protect them from fatigue, distraction, or error. Let their actions be guided by Your wisdom, and surround them with Your grace.

Father, as I travel, I ask that You protect me not only physically but also spiritually. Guard me against any attacks of the enemy, distractions, or temptations that could lead me away from You. Help me to stay rooted in Your Word, even while on the move. Keep my mind fixed on You, for Your Word promises, “You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in You” (Isaiah 26:3).

LORD, I lift up my loved ones to You. Whether they are traveling alongside me or on their own journeys, I ask that You cover them with the blood of Jesus. Protect them from accidents, harm, or danger. Keep us connected in spirit, even when we are apart. Let us all return safely to one another, giving thanks for Your goodness and faithfulness.

Father, I pray for discernment not just for this trip but for every decision I make. Proverbs 22:3 says, “The prudent see danger and take refuge, but the simple keep going and pay the penalty.” Make me prudent, LORD. If there is a situation, destination, or timing that is not part of Your perfect will, help me to recognize it and choose obedience over my own desires. Teach me to value Your direction above all else, knowing that Your ways are higher than my ways, and Your thoughts are higher than my thoughts (Isaiah 55:8-9).

LORD, I ask for protection from being in the wrong place at the wrong time. You are the GOD who orders my steps (Proverbs 16:9), and I trust that You will lead me where I need to be. Let every delay, every change of plans, and every unexpected turn be seen as part of Your divine orchestration for my good and Your glory.

Finally, LORD, I pray for Your presence to go with me. Moses said in Exodus 33:15, “If Your presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here.” I echo this prayer, knowing that without You, I am vulnerable and lost. Be my guide, my shield, and my peace. Let this journey, and every journey I take, be a testimony of Your faithfulness and goodness.

Thank You, LORD, for hearing my prayer and for being my ever-present help in times of need. I trust You completely and surrender every step of this journey to You. I declare that You are my GOD, my Protector, and my Savior.
