

SCRIPTURE: PSALM 14

NOTES

Foolish Denial of God:

The psalm begins by stating that fools deny the existence of God, living as if there is no divine authority.

Assessment of Humanity's Corruption:

The psalmist observes that humanity, in their denial of God, has become corrupt, with no one seeking to do what is right.

God's Perspective:

God looks down from heaven to see if anyone is wise and seeks Him, but the psalmist finds that all have turned away, engaging in wickedness.

A Call for Deliverance:

The psalmist expresses a desire for God to bring salvation to His people, to restore joy and protect them from the schemes of the wicked.

Hope in God's Salvation:

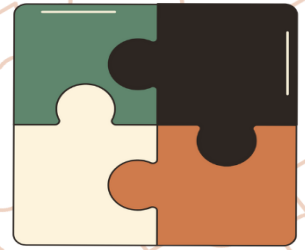
The psalm concludes with hope, anticipating that God will bring salvation to Israel and restore the fortunes of His people.

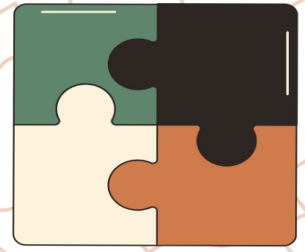

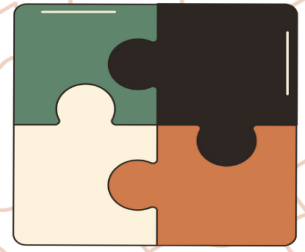
