FATHER, I also pray against every spiritual attack that tries to take advantage of my mental state. The enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy, but YOU have come to give life and life abundantly. I declare that my mind belongs to YOU, LORD. I plead the blood of JESUS over my thoughts, emotions, and mental health. No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue that rises against me in judgment will be condemned.

Renew my mind daily through YOUR Word, LORD. Help me to remember that my identity is not found in my struggles but in YOU. I am more than a conqueror through CHRIST who loves me. Even on the hardest days, remind me that YOUR grace is sufficient and YOUR strength is made perfect in my weakness.

Thank YOU for being my refuge, my healer, and my peace. I trust that YOU are working in me, even when progress feels slow. I believe that YOU will restore my mind, heal my heart, and renew my spirit in YOUR perfect time.
