



Prayer for Comfort in Grief

Heavenly FATHER, I come to YOU with a heart that feels shattered and weighed down by the loss I am experiencing. LORD, the pain is overwhelming, and I do not know how to carry it. But YOUR Word reminds me that YOU are near to the brokenhearted and save those who are crushed in spirit (Psalm 34:18). So here I am, LORD, bringing my sorrow and tears before YOU, trusting that YOU see me and understand my grief.

LORD, YOU are the GOD of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles (2 Corinthians 1:3-4). I need YOUR comfort now more than ever. Wrap me in YOUR loving arms and remind me that even in my darkest moments, YOU are my refuge and strength, my ever-present help in trouble (Psalm 46:1). Teach me to lean on YOU when my heart feels too heavy to bear.

YOUR Word tells me that there is a time for everything and a season for every activity under the heavens: a time to be born and a time to die, a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance (Ecclesiastes 3:1-4). LORD, I am in a season of mourning, and I ask for the grace to walk through this grief with YOU by my side. Teach me to grieve as one who has hope, for YOU have promised eternal life to those who believe in YOU (1 Thessalonians 4:13-14).

Father, I lift up my pain to YOU, trusting that YOU are the healer of broken hearts. YOUR Word says YOU heal the brokenhearted and bind up their wounds (Psalm 147:3). I surrender my wounds to YOU, LORD, and ask that YOU bring healing in YOUR perfect time. Help me to trust in YOUR process, even when it feels slow and uncertain.

Thank YOU, LORD, for the hope that one day, YOU will wipe every tear from my eyes. There will be no more death, mourning, crying, or pain, for the old order of things will pass away (Revelation 21:4). Until that day, help me to fix my eyes on YOU, the Author and Perfector of my faith (Hebrews 12:2). Strengthen me to endure this season with hope and trust in YOUR promises.

LORD, I am struggling with the emptiness left by this loss. I miss the presence of the one I loved so deeply. But YOU remind me that even when I feel alone, YOU are with me. YOUR Word says, "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Deuteronomy 31:8). Fill the void in my heart with YOUR presence and remind me that YOU are all-sufficient.

Help me to cast all my anxiety and sorrow on YOU because YOU care for me (1 Peter 5:7). Let me find rest in YOUR promises, knowing that YOU are my Shepherd, and even as I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for YOU are with me. YOUR rod and YOUR staff comfort me (Psalm 23:4). Guide me through this dark valley with YOUR Word as my strength.

LORD, I also ask for strength for the days ahead. There are moments when I do not know how to face tomorrow, but I hold on to YOUR promise that YOUR mercies are new every morning, and great is YOUR faithfulness (Lamentations 3:22-23). Give me the grace to take one step at a time, trusting that YOU will provide the strength I need for each day.

Father, I pray for the people around me who are also grieving. Bring us together in unity, support, and love. Help us to comfort one another with the same comfort YOU give us (2 Corinthians 1:4). Let YOUR peace, which surpasses all understanding, guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7).
