



Heavenly FATHER,

I come before YOU today with a heart that longs for true, Christ-centered friendships and godly sisterhood. I lift my friendships and my desire for godly sisterhood into YOUR hands, asking YOU to shape, strengthen, and align them according to YOUR divine will.

FATHER, I confess that there have been times when friendships have left me hurt, disappointed, or feeling unseen. Sometimes, I have struggled with comparison, jealousy, or mistrust, and other times I have built walls to protect myself from being hurt again. But YOU remind me in YOUR Word that iron sharpens iron, and that two are better than one because they can help each other succeed. Teach me to love others with a pure heart, to forgive quickly, and to show grace as YOU have shown me grace.

LORD, I ask YOU to surround me with women who will uplift me in prayer, speak truth in love, and challenge me to grow in my walk with YOU. I desire friendships that reflect YOUR heart, where honesty, encouragement, and accountability flow freely. Remove any toxic or ungodly connections that may hinder my spiritual growth. If there are friendships that are seasonal and need to be released, help me to let them go with peace and wisdom. If there are friendships that need healing, I ask for YOUR restoration and reconciliation to take place according to YOUR perfect will.

FATHER, I also pray that YOU would help me to be a godly friend. Teach me to listen with compassion, to speak words of life, and to be dependable and loyal. Let me reflect the love of Christ in the way I treat others, not seeking my own interests but looking out for the good of my sisters in Christ. Let my friendships be marked by kindness, humility, and a shared pursuit of YOU above all else.

LORD, I lift up the need for spiritual mentorship and discipleship. I ask that YOU bring wise, godly women into my life who can speak into my journey, offer guidance, and model what it means to follow YOU faithfully. Likewise, help me to pour into others who may be younger in the faith, encouraging and discipling them with patience and love. Let these relationships form a beautiful tapestry of godly sisterhood, where each woman plays her part in building up the Body of Christ.

FATHER, in moments when I feel lonely or disconnected, remind me that YOU are my closest friend and constant companion. YOU promise to never leave me nor forsake me, and YOUR love is the foundation upon which all other relationships should be built. Teach me to trust YOU with my friendships, knowing that YOU know what and who I need in each season of my life.

LORD, I pray for protection over every friendship. Guard against division, gossip, envy, and misunderstanding. Let forgiveness flow easily, and let Christ always remain at the center. Strengthen the bonds of sisterhood so that together, we may pray, worship, serve, and encourage one another to become all YOU have called us to be.

## Scripture References

1. **Ecclesiastes 4:9–10** — “Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor. If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.”
