

## More Than Free Synopsis

Nearly 4000 years ago, a simple farmer named Jacob, headed a large family that flourished, and over the centuries founded many nations. Later in life he was renamed Israel. He was over 90 years old when he started his family of two wives, two concubines, 15 daughters and 12 sons. The sons formed the heads of the 12 Tribes of Israel. This is the story of one man's family through time, the nations they built and people with which they interacted. It's a story of the wars they fought, and the family tree from them is one descending tangled, intertwined branch of genealogy through time. It is a sliver of history running narrow and deep through the passages of time from light of ancient Israel to the shining city on the hill in 21st century America. This book shreds the revisionist view of history, and asks the question why have so many important facts in history been changed. What is the purpose of the lies and coverups? What conflicts were set in the ancient bloodlines of the people that mask real history and keep us ignorant and uninformed? The stories pull equally from the coasts of the Mediterranean, western Asia, the Baltic, the North Sea, continental Europe, the British Isles and finally America. Tied umbilical cord to umbilical cord through time, the generations of the Tribes of Israel interconnect and link together in ways lost to its generations and history.

The story in the Old Testament sets the foundation of the 12 Tribes. They occupied the vales of Hebron until severe drought drove them into Egypt to find food on the fertile delta of the Nile River. Here they were saved by their brother Joseph who, through a vicious twist of fate, was running the agriculture and building projects for the Pharaoh. After 400 years, the Bible tells of the Exodus of Moses by land but we are taught nothing of the water exodus of the Zarahites of Judah, the exploits of the Danites, or the rebellion of the Simeonites. Troy was a remarkable city state built by the Zarahites near the western Anatolian coast, but the story is wrapped in confusing mythology so as not to be understood. After the fall of Troy, many descendants became Greek slaves, but eventually escaped in the Celtic migration to southern England. Here they founded Totnes (modern-day London). The Danites became part of the great Phoenician trading empire that supported Solomon building the Temple of God and the great chariot cities throughout Israel. And Danites were the Nordic chiefs of ancient Scandinavia.

The northern ten tribes rebelled against the rule of the kings of Judah after Solomon died, and a brutal civil war over taxation split the kingdom into two. The Northern Kingdom of Israel fell into Baal worship, and became morally weak over the next two centuries. The Assyrians to the east had gained a significant empire, and eventually turned their hate and enormous army towards Israel. Over two decades the Northern Kingdom of Israel was wiped off the map by the Assyrian army, and the people were driven north like cattle into modern-day Syria and southern Turkey. From this time the northern ten tribes of Israel were lost to Western history.

Yet some of the ten tribes escaped into Armenia ahead of the Assyrian invasions, and crossed the Caucasus mountains into eastern Europe. Simultaneously, to avoid the terrible power of the Assyrians, the Phoenicians began to move their trading operations from the eastern Mediterranean to Carthage on the north coast of Africa. As Phoenicia faded, Carthage inherited all of the Phoenician trade routes, and Israelites traveled around the globe and to America.

In coming centuries, Assyria weakened to stronger neighboring powers, and the enslaved tribes escaped bondage. They were never again called by their Israelite tribal names. The Scythian tribes were comprised of the very large western and eastern branches of Manasseh, and rural Judah. By 500 BC they lived as nomadic herdsmen across the steppe country from the Black Sea and into what is modern-day Ukraine and southern Russia today. The Black Sea Scythians by 200 BC were pushed into Europe by other westward migrating tribes. Some of them split off into the southern Alps, and were called Allemanni. The tribes of rural Judah today are called Ashkenazi Jews, or those who lived inside the Roman Empire and were never part of the Babylonian captivity.

The heart of northern Israel, the Samaritans, was pushed east and north into Asia where after they escaped founded the Empire of Parthia east of the Euphrates River. For hundreds of years the Parthians were a strong counterpoise to the Roman Empire, and in battle they were never defeated in battle by them. Because of their own strength and discipline, the Parthians weren't afraid of the Romans. Our Western history are silent about the Parthians.

Jesus was born at a time of peace between the Roman and Parthian Empires, but His birth caused an international incident that nearly led to war. The Magi traveled a thousand miles from Parthia to Jerusalem, and when they arrived they were accompanied by a large contingent of Parthian troops. Herod and the people of Jerusalem were alarmed. The Parthians found Jesus in Bethlehem and brought great gifts of gold and precious items. When suddenly they had the means, Mary and Joseph fled to Egypt with baby Jesus to escape Herod.

As a teenager, Jesus traveled with his great uncle, Joseph of Arimathea, to the south coast of Briton where Joseph secured tin from the Cornish mines for shipment to the Roman processing furnaces. Joseph placed Jesus with the Druid priests on the Isle of Avalon, modern-day Glastonbury, England, where He spent many years preparing for His ministry. Avalon remained protected from Roman hands for centuries. Christianity was first established in Briton in 38 AD by Joseph some years after Jesus was crucified. Rome passed the Claudian edict in 42 AD, which led to the murder of millions of Christians. Paul arrived in Rome in 43 AD, and Peter in 44 AD.

Despite their centuries of advanced civilization, the Parthians grew complacent and eventually fell to the vassal Persians. When they were defeated, they fell hard and completely. They fled en masse over the Caucasus mountains into Europe as the Anguls, Saxons, Danes and Jutes. Other Lost Tribes of Israel migrated out of Asia into Europe over the centuries both by sea and the land route over the Caucasus Mountains. They were both pulled and pushed by the unseen hand of God. Over time they overwhelmed and occupied Europe, the British Isles, Ireland and Scandinavia. Each of these movements of the people was the result of the major events of the times, usually wars or invasions, sometimes natural events. Where are these facts in Western history?

By 225 AD, the Huns attacked the migrants in eastern Europe, who fled ahead of the attackers into central Europe. Within a decade the Gothic population in central Europe became very large, and included Saxons, Franks, Lombards, Alemanni, Burgundians, Vandals and others. In Europe the people settled with their natural tribes into kingdoms in Germany, Scotland, Wales, Denmark, England, Sweden, and France, and fought in alliance against the Roman Empire in Europe. These tribes did not fear the Romans.

The Church and the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation dominated central Europe for another 400 years. Many then suffered from this time through the reformation of the Catholic Church and civil wars throughout Europe. Mass migrations to and the rise of America took another 400 years. This period of European settlement in America and Canada began the period where history is blended with the genealogy of the numerous tribal lineages and nations into the American ethos. The genealogies of 119 generations from present America back to Jacob connect this author and ancient Israel. The various branches lurch and careen through history all the while collapsing in on itself as tangled families in the melting pot of America.

An amazing hidden history led to America. All of the tribal branches interconnect in family genealogies in northern Europe, America and Canada. Our ancestors blazed their way through 4000 years of history, and today America stands as a wounded nation suffering under the same murderous path of sacrificing its children to Baal and Molek. A big difference now is that there is no place left to run, no place where we can leave our hideous, war torn past.
