Leader's Announcements

- Ollie Somervell from the Communications Team has left after 5 years at the Council.
- The Local Plan consultation and Cirencester Town Centre MasterPlan consultation closed on 7 April.
- Re: The issue of coach parking in Bourton-on-the-Water. The Leader attended a meeting hosted by the Member of Parliament for the Cotswolds Sir Geoffrey Clifton-Brown. It was highlighted that this is a traffic issue and that the Councils interest is providing community leadership and assisting where it can in finding a solution. The proposal to adjust the use of the Rissington Road car park was not seen as viable due to the revenue budget loss and the large capital funds needed to create a facility for coach parking. The Council will look at proposals and continue to engage with the communities on solutions.
- The Council is celebrating its 50th anniversary since its creation in 1974 and that over the summer there would be a number of events to mark the history of the Council.

There were no recommendations from the Overview and Scrutiny Committee or issues arising from the Audit and Governance Committee.
