Overnight closure along Leckhampton Hill on weekend 27/28 April

Kier Transportation is working on behalf of National Highways to improve the existing A417. We're writing to inform you that as part of the ongoing improvements to the network, there will be an overnight closure in place along Leckhampton Hill.

This closure is to enable tree and vegetation clearance works to be undertaken along Leckhampton Hill between the Air Balloon roundabout and Ullenwood Manor Road. Overhead cables outage has also been booked for 28 April to enable works close to the overhead cables.

These works will involve tree and vegetation clearance, tree stumps removal, and chipping of the arisings on site.

Overnight closure along Leckhampton Hill:

- Saturday 27 April from 9pm, reopening on Sunday 28 April at 6am
- Sunday 28 April from 9pm, reopening on Monday 29 April at 6am

Time of Closure each night: 9pm – 6am

Location: Leckhampton Hill between the Air Balloon roundabout and Ullenwood Manor Road.

A diversion route will be in place via Leckhampton Hill, A40, A435 to A436, and has been agreed with Gloucestershire County Council.

Please see the red line on the map shown below highlighting the closure, with the approved diversion route shown in blue.



National Star College and Crickley Hill Country Park will be open for business as usual.

Please note that these works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Access for emergency services will be fully maintained during the closures.
