



# Field Trips - Fall 2026

Silver Bell Farm invites schools, daycares, and educational groups to experience fall on the farm in a fun, hands-on way.

Each visit is carefully organized and fully guided by our staff, with your group moving through activities together from start to finish. Teachers and chaperones can relax and enjoy the experience while we handle the flow of the day. Students love the variety of activities and the chance to experience the farm in a way that keeps them engaged the entire time.

We offer a standard field trip package outlined below, with options to customize based on your group's needs. Please feel free to reach out for more information.

**Trip Information:** Standard field trips include a tractor-pulled wagon ride, a Barrel Train ride, pumpkin decorating (including a sugar pumpkin for each student to take home), a guided farm activity (such as a storytime or scavenger hunt), and access to games and activities on the farm, including time to visit and interact with our goats. A trip through the Corn Maze may also be included (ask for availability). Groups are welcome to stay and have lunch on the farm following their scheduled activities.

**Age Groups:** Pre K - 4th Grade

**Trip Length:** Field trips typically begin between 9:30 – 10:00AM and last approximately 1.5 to 2 hours.

**Rates:** \$12.00 per student, \$5.00 per parent/chaperone, No charge for teachers and school staff

**Minimum Group Size:** Field trips are scheduled as private experiences for each school. A minimum of **80 students** is required to reserve a field trip date. Schools with fewer than 80 students are welcome to attend with a minimum payment equivalent to 80 students.
