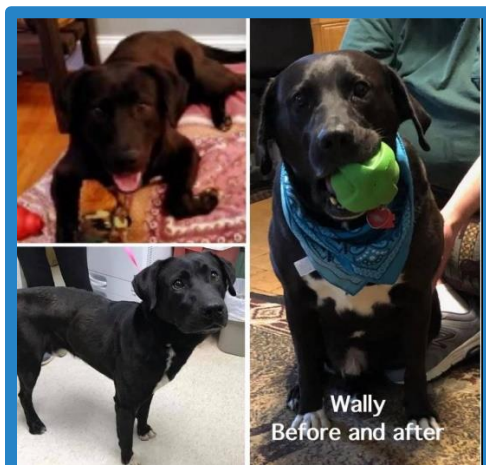

## TREATS? CATS LOVE 'EM, TOO!

Never made cat treats before? They're easy and healthy treats for your kitty friends!

### HOMEMADE CAT TREATS

#### Ingredients:

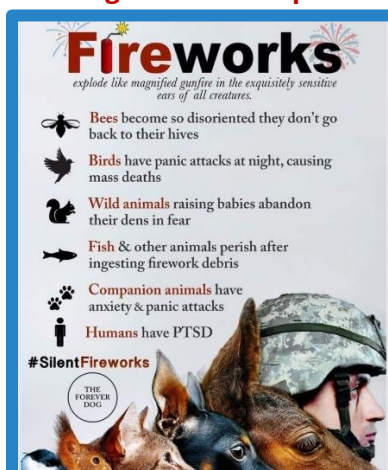
- 1 can [tuna in oil](#), drained
- 1 egg
- 1 ¼ cups of flour, plus extra for dusting
- ½ cup water
- dash of parsley
- bottle cap for cutting out treats

#### Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350.
2. In a food processor mix tuna, egg, flour, water and parsley until a dough forms. If the dough looks too sticky, add a bit more flour.
3. Dust a surface with flour and roll out dough to ½ inch thick.
4. Use a bottle cap to cut out treats from the dough.
5. Bake for 20 minutes on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper.
6. Let cool and serve to your cat.
