

As coaches of the Scotland Bombers, we have made a commitment to the players and to the parents. Now we are asking for the same commitment from the players and parents. This form is to state our rules, regulations and requirements to be part of the team.

- 1. Dues will be paid the 1st of every month. Dues are \$50 per player. Any player that has not paid their dues by the 10th will not be allowed to play that month, unless arrangements have been made.
- 2. We need all players at practice. Three (3) unexcused absences will result in dismissal from the team.
- 3. Players should always give 100%!
- 4. Players should come to practice dressed, prepared and ready to learn. (softball pants, shirt and cleats)
- 5. Cleats will be put on before entering gate at the field and will not be removed until you exit the gate. This goes for practice and games.
- 6. Players will carry their own equipment bags.
- 7. Players will respect each other and coaches.
- 8. Parents are requested to cheer on the team and offer positive encouragement to the players, but it is the coach's responsibility to coach the team.
- 9. Parents will allow the coaches to coach your child.
- 10. No parent shall disrespect another player, coach or another team at any time.
- 11. No parent or family member will be allowed in the dugout at any time unless asked by one of the coaches.
- 12. All players are required to run on and off the field. (Practice and games)
- 13. All players will remain in the dugout until the game is over.
- 14. No cell phones out in the dugout until the game or practice is over.
- 15. No horse playing at any time.
- 16. Players will sit and rest between games as a team until warm-ups begin.
- 17. All players will show good sportsmanship to other teams, coaches and umpires.
- 18. All batting line-ups and players position will be determined by the coaching staff.
- 19. The coach has the right to call and play guest player as seen fit.
- 20. If a player cannot make a tournament the coaching staff will be notified ahead of time so arrangements can be made to fill that spot. Tournaments cost too much money to not have enough players to play.
- 21. All tournaments will be paid out of dues. (Except the bigger tournaments)

Players breaking the rules will be subject to sitting out innings, sitting our entire games, or even being dismissed be the team. Disciplinary action will be determined by the coaching staff.
