2023 CSA Membership Agreement Terms & Conditions

We, Farmer Dave CSA (referred to as “we” or “the farm”), wish to provide you with fresh, local, seasonal food and you, the member, wish to receive a portion of our harvest. This agreement outlines our shared commitments to that relationship.

Section 1. Introducing our CSA Farm

A. Becoming a Part of Our Farm

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between our farm and you as our customer. Rather than simply purchasing food, our customers become “members” of this CSA farm who receive a portion of the farm’s harvest.

Our 2023 CSA runs for 22 weeks, from May 17, 2023 to October 22, 2023. Members are responsible for showing up at 317 Dogtail Corners Rd., Wingdale, NY on your scheduled pick-up date to receive your share of freshly harvested produce. We are not responsible for your shares of produce that have not been picked up on your scheduled pick-up date.

B. The Products We Expect for 2023

The chart on the next page outlines the vegetables, herbs, etc. that we hope to deliver and when you may see them in your share. The chart is based on our best estimates, but of course weather, pests, and other events will affect actual production. In any given year, there are always certain crops that do better than others (it all depends on the weather, pests, etc.), and sometimes a certain vegetable crop may fail in a given year. Therefore, even though we will plant everything from the following list, we cannot guarantee that you will receive each of the items listed on the following chart (see next page).

C. Sharing in the Risk of Crop Failure

We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The amount of produce, however, may vary from week-to-week due to weather, insects, or other production factors despite our best efforts. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failures with us and other members.

Crop failures can occur as a result of factors outside of our control, and in any given year there will be crop failures & crop successes. When a crop fails, we compensate for the failed crops by filling your share with other crops grown on the farm that are ready for harvest at that time, if possible. For example, if there's a drought and we're unable to provide green beans, our CSA members will receive more of other vegetables instead. The overall share size does not change.

Section 2. Member Fees

By selling membership in advance of the growing season, CSA reduces the burden of upfront costs for the farmer. Your membership fees provide us with money to purchase seed and equipment before the season starts, and we appreciate your commitment.
