

Sts Mary Magdalene and Markella Greek Orthodox Church Philoptochos Scholarship

Two (2) \$500 Scholarship Awards for 2019

1. The scholarship awards shall be in the amount of \$500 each. The first scholarship is sponsored by The Ladies of Philoptochos. The second scholarship is sponsored by Mrs. Irene Tsambikos in memory of her beloved son Bill Tsambikos. These are non-renewable scholarships.
2. Applicants must be of the Greek Orthodox faith, one of whose parents (mother or father) is a member in good standing of Sts. Mary Magdalene and Markella Church for a minimum of (2) years. Applicant must be of the residence of the parent who is the member of Sts Mary Magdalene and Markella Church.
3. Applicants must be a senior in high school.
4. The scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of Scholastic Achievement, Character and Parish Involvement, without reference to financial need.
5. Applicants are advised that the quality of their involvement in parish activities and programs will be considered an IMPORTANT criterion for selection of scholarship recipients. Active participation in church programs will be used to help determine awards.
6. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. an official transcript of grades for 4 years
 - b. an essay of less than 200 words attached to the application on “What are your future goals and aspirations after high school?”
 - c. the completed application
7. Applicants must be accepted for admission to an accredited two or four year college or university whose course of study leads to the award of a degree.
