

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LATERAL FIREFIGHTER-EMT

Grant County Fire District 8 (GCFD8) is accepting applications to establish an eligibility list for the position of Lateral Firefighter-EMT.

District Profile:

Grant County Fire District 8 is located in South Central Washington and is a rural combination fire department with a response area of 248 square miles. We responded to 580 calls in 2019 from three stations with 73% EMS related, 11% wildland fires, and the balance being structure and other types of fire calls. Call volume has increased nearly 40% in the past five years. We provide structure and wildland fire suppression, BLS transport, hazardous materials response and rescue, and fire prevention education to our citizens.

We are in the process of constructing a new Headquarters Fire Station to be completed by late spring 2021. This station will have career and resident housing along with space for a future ladder truck. Current strategic initiatives include continuing to upgrade capital facilities, increase staffing as budget allows, developing personnel, and capital replacement of the fleet. We take pride in continually improving the services that we deliver to our community.
