Grant County Fire District 8 (District) is accepting applications to establish an ongoing eligibility list for the position of Resident Firefighter and fill two open positions.

District Profile:

Grant County Fire District 8 is located in South Central Washington and is a rural combination fire department with a response area of 248 square miles. We responded to 702 calls in 2022 from three stations with approximately 82% EMS related, 10% wildland fires, and the balance being structure and other types of fire calls. Call volume has increased 21% in the past four years. We provide structure and wildland fire suppression, BLS transport, hazardous materials response and rescue, and fire prevention education to our citizens.

We operate from the new Headquarters station that has career staff and resident housing, a 100-ft. platform ladder truck, a structure engine, two wildland trucks, a tactical water tender, a quick response brush truck, and two ambulances. Current strategic initiatives include continuing to upgrade capital facilities, increase staffing as budget allows, developing personnel, and capital replacement of the fleet. We take pride in continually improving the services that we deliver to our community.
