

## Volunteer Position Descriptions

Title: Traffic Control Specialist

Purpose/Objective:

- To provide a safe working area for Fire and EMS personnel
- Alert drivers of incident
- Protect the Responders and patients
- Could respond to multiple types of incidents (HAZMAT; MVA, EMS, FIRES.)

Key Responsibilities:

- Be able to establish a secure scene during an incident
- Be able to communicate with IC and others units on scene for traffic control

Qualifications:

- Good driving record (speeding tickets; at fault accidents; seatbelt tickets)
- Good standing citizen within the community ( background check)
- WA state driver's license
- Good vision

Time Commitment

- Respond to calls requiring the need for traffic control (10%)
- Attend at least 1 Fire or 1 EMS drill a month. To be familiar with policies and practices.
- Possibly be on scene for extended amounts of time
- 4 trainings a year headed by the Traffic Control Supervisor
