## MEMBER NEWS

### *A Year in Patches*

Roberta Garriss' temperature quilt, *A Year in Patches*, has been selected for inclusion in the 2024 International Quilt Festival Judged Show. The IQF is the largest annual quilt show in the U.S. and takes place each fall in Houston TX. The Festival regularly attracts more than 40,000 people from all around the world and features more than 1,200 quilts on display. The dates are October 31st to November 3rd, 2024



Roberta first heard about temperature quilts in an article in Quilting Arts magazine, but was inspired to make one by Janine Smith. A temperature quilt uses a quilt block to track the high and low temperatures of each day in a given location over the course of a whole year.

Roberta's quilt features a house block, the left-hand side represents the high temperature, the right-hand side represents the low temperature, and the background represents the daily precipitation; clear, rain, hail, snow, and rainbow. Roberta used number breaks to mark the months.
