

# Introduction to Foundation Paper Piecing Supply List

\*Fabric Strips-Light and dark, at least 2 ½" wide  
(great way to use up left over jelly roll strips)

or

1 yard each of a light and dark fabric-can be  
multiple designs

(if using strips, be sure to bring some 5" squares for  
center of pattern)

\*Small roller (used for FPP) or small iron

\*Add A Quarter Plus ruler (it's very helpful to have this  
tool. If you don't want to invest in another tool you  
may never use again, bring a regular 12 inch or larger  
quilting ruler and post card or other rigid paper card)

Optional: 90/14 sewing needle (larger needle)

Foundation papers and washable glue stick will be  
provided in class.

## Other Items Required:

Sewing machine with new needle

Neutral thread

Cutting mat, pressing surface, rotary cutter, scissors

All usual sewing notions
