# Safety Reminders

- 1 Slow down Our speed limit is 25 mph. We have numerous young children that ride bikes and play out in front of their houses. We ask parents to talk with their teens and their guest who may be visiting Weddington Chase and ask them to please slow down.
- <u>2 Lock your vehicles -</u> While we have not had an increase in theft from vehicles, our surrounding areas have seen an uptick. Please do not leave your cars unlocked or leave keys, fobs, money, and other valuables visible.
- <u>3 Garage doors -</u> Do not leave your garage doors open unless you are in your garage. It just takes a matter of seconds for someone to slip in and remove property or, even worse, enter your home.
- <u>4 -Lighting -</u> During the evening hours, it's advisable to leave some exterior lights on.

- <u>5 Alarms</u> If your house has an alarm, it's highly advised that you always use this feature. In addition, please ensure that your sign is visible from the street.

# Golf Cart Safety

If you own a golf cart or are considering buying one, we ask that you please use good judgement when operating it and follow the ordinances set forth by the City of Marvin. We all want a safe and enjoyable Weddington Chase and appreciate your attention to this information.

REF: (Ord. OR-2009-10-01, passed 9-8-2009; Ord. OR-2012-12-01, passed 12-11-2012)

- 1.) Operators must have a valid driver's license and the operator must carry a license when operating a Golf Cart.
- 2.) Any person who operates a Golf Cart must be responsible for all liability associated with operation of the golf cart and must have liability insurance coverage which will cover the use of a Golf Cart in the amount not less than required by North Carolina law for motor vehicles operating on public roads in the state of North Carolina.
- 3.) Golf Carts may not exceed speeds of 20 MPH.
- 4.) Golf Carts may be operated on public streets without a brake light if the operator uses appropriate hand signals.
- 5.) Golf Carts may not be operated after sunset unless they have two lighted lamps, one on each side of the front of the Golf Cart visible at night under normal conditions and a red lamp on the rear visible at night under normal conditions.
- 6.) An operator may not allow the number of people in the Golf Cart at any one time to exceed the maximum capacity specified by the manufacturer. The operator shall not allow occupants to ride on any part of the Golf Cart not designated to carry passengers such as part of the cart designed to carry golf bags.
- 7.) Golf Carts must be operated at the right edge of the roadway and must yield to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
- 8.) No golf cart containing any open container of alcohol shall be operating on public streets, roads, or highways. Operators of Golf Carts may not be under the influence of alcohol.

# **Amenity Reminders**

- 1.) Amenities Use: Non-Resident use of Weddington Chase amenities is strictly prohibited unless authorized by the WC Board of Directors. Invited guests are welcome and are limited to a maximum of 2 per household per day and must be always accompanied by the host resident during their visit. This guest limitation pertains to all amenities, including the playground, tennis courts, basketball court, and pool. Our priority is to our residents and their families and any exceptions to the guest policy must be prior approved by the Board.
- 2.) Gates and Doors: Security barriers are there for your protection and the safety and security of our community and amenities. POOL GATES, TENNIS GATES, and BATHROOM DOORS should NOT be propped open with objects or secured open in any manner at any time. The gates and doors are key fob controlled and protect our amenities from unauthorized use and pose a serious safety issue when not allowed to close properly. Please be on the lookout for non-resident "tailgating", an action where a non-resident follows a resident in entry ways without a key fob. If someone doesn't have a fob and you don't know them, please do not let them in.
- 3.) Child Supervision: Children aged 14 and under must be always accompanied by an adult without exception. Please SUPERVISE your children do not leave minors unattended at any of the amenities including the playground, tennis courts, basketball, gym, and pool areas. Please refrain from climbing on tables and on areas of the playground that are not designed for climbing. Dropping off minors without adult supervision is strictly prohibited, so please ensure minors are accompanied and always supervised.

#### 4) Tennis, Basketball, and Volleyball Courts:

Unauthorized use of the tennis, basketball, and volleyball courts is considered TRESPASSING and should be reported immediately to the non-emergency Sheriff's office at (704) 283-3789. Invited guests are welcome and are limited to a maximum of 2 per household per day and must be always accompanied by the host resident during their visit. The priority of all courts is to our residents and their families and any exceptions to the guest policy must be prior approved by the Board.
