WC Updates and Improvements

TENNIS COURTS

New LED lights were installed on the tennis courts last Summer which not only improved night playing conditions, but also provides electric savings. New timers were also installed. Tennis resurfacing is scheduled for this spring to repair the cracks that have developed. A different process than was used a few years ago will improve the lifetime of the courts.

Tennis courts are for tennis play ONLY. Tennis Court playing time is by reservation. Bicycles, skateboards, and motorized vehicles are prohibited. Children should not be on the tennis courts unattended. Misuse of the courts can result in your FOB privileges being revoked and any damages can be charged back to your account.

WALKING PATHS

While we have made necessary repairs to the walking trails over the last couple years. The board will continue to look at the paths and make any additional necessary repairs/replacement as needed and in conjunction with evaluating all capital expenses.

OTHER PROJECTS

The Board is evaluating other projects including, but not limited to; additional cameras around the tennis and basketball courts, replacement of some clubhouse exterior doors, new flooring in the hallway and kitchen of the clubhouse, pickleball court options and "baby pool" options.

POOL MANAGEMENT COMPANY

AquaTech Pool Management was signed to a new contract to maintain our pool. The pump motor was replaced last

year, and we know that repairs will be needed this spring on other major components. We have budgeted for those repairs.

LANDSCAPE COMPANY

We have renewed our contract with Landscape Solutions based on their work in 2022. In addition to all landscaping requirements, they handle irrigation, up lighting, spring and fall flower planting, trash, and pet waste removal alone the paths and other related services as needed.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

VEHICLE PARKING

In the Evenings, please park your cars in your driveways, not on the street.

MAILBOXES

Mailboxes need to be properly maintained and in good condition. Black paint, gold numbers and a red flag.

POND

The WC Pond is catch and release. We have a neighborhood pool, so please do not swim in the pond. We also ask that you not let your animals swim in it as there is the potential issue of entanglement and potential damage to our pond aeration system. Net fishing is NOT permitted.

CLUBHOUSE RENTAL

As a reminder the clubhouse is available to rent by residents and their immediate families. Rentals to non-residents and friends outside the neighborhood is not permitted.

Thank you for doing your part in keeping Weddington Chase looking clean and tidy.

Flock Update

Here are some initial insights for the period of December 5th, 2022 – January 3rd, 2023:

Total Plate Reads: 46,919

Average Day Total Traffic:

1,675 cars from all entrances

- → Hickory had 62% of entrance traffic & 64% of the exit traffic
- → Single highest day 2,148 (December 16th).


As a comparison, when this was installed:

Total Plate Reads: 51K

Average Day Total Traffic:

1,800 cars from all entrances

→ Single highest day in 30-day period 2,078 (Sept 17th).




WC Covenant Reminders & Village Rules

The HOA wanted to send out a few reminders and neighborly tips:

 We have many new neighbors as well as many neighbors still working from home because of the pandemic and to be courteous to all, please remember the following:







Article VI: Use Restrictions and Rules: Section 6. Animals & Pets:

No animals, livestock or poultry of any kind may be raised, bred, kept or permitted in the Community, except that dogs, cats or other usual and common household pets in reasonable number, as determined by the Board, may be kept on a Lot; provided, however, those pets which are permitted to roam free, or, in the sole discretion of the Board, make objectionable noise or endanger the health of or constitute a nuisance or inconvenience to the Owners of other Lots or the owner of any property located adjacent to the Community may be removed by the Board. No pets shall be kept, bred, or maintained for any commercial purpose. Dogs shall always whenever they are outside a Lot be confined on a leash. Without prejudice to the Board's right to remove any such household pets, no household pet that has caused damage or injury may be walked in the Community.

Article VI: Use Restrictions and Rules: Section 7. Nuisance:

It shall be the responsibility of each Owner and Occupant to prevent the development of any unclean, unhealthy, unsightly, or unkempt condition on his or her Lot. No Lot shall be used, in whole or in part, for the storage of any property or thing that will cause such Lot to appear to be in an unclean or untidy condition or that will be obnoxious to the eye; nor shall any substance, thing or material be kept upon any Lot that will emit foul or obnoxious odors or that will cause any noise or other condition that will or might disturb the peace, quiet, safety, comfort or serenity of the occupants of surrounding property. No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any Lot, nor shall anything be done thereon tending to cause embarrassment, discomfort, annoyance, or nuisance to any person using any property adjacent to the Lot. There shall not be maintained any plants or animals or device or thing of any sort whose activities or existence in any way is noxious, dangerous, unsightly, unpleasant or of a nature as may diminish or destroy the enjoyment of the Community. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, no speaker, horn, whistle, siren, bell, amplifier, or other sound device, except such devices as may be used exclusively for security purposes, shall be located, installed, or maintained upon the exterior of any Lot unless required by law.

Article VI: Use Restrictions and Rules: Section 23. Detached Structures

No detached structure shall be placed, erected, allowed, or maintained upon any Lot or within the Community without the prior written consent of the Board or its designee. All detached structures must be consistent in design materials and color with the dwelling on the Lot.

Article VI: Use Restrictions and Rules: Section 2. Use of Lots

All Lots shall be used for single-family residential purposes exclusively, and no trade, business or business activity of any kind shall be carried on or conducted in, from or upon any Lot or any part of the Community at any time without the prior written approval of the Board, except that the Owner or Occupant residing on a Lot may conduct such ancillary business activities within the residence under certain strict conditions as outlined in the Covenants.

Shared Community Grounds:

If you would like to use the WC shared community grounds and amenities for personal use, please contact Greenway for Board Approval. Scheduling is required. Some areas require reservations as additional staffing or cleaning may be needed.

Village of Marvin:

§ 92.02 ACTS DECLARED TO BE NUISANCES.

The following acts are declared to be nuisances in violation of this chapter, but the enumeration shall not be deemed to be exclusive:



(D) It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to emit or cause to be emitted any noise across a property line or to a public street, sidewalk, or public vehicular area in excess of 65 dBA between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Friday or Saturday or 50 dBA at any other time, as measured anywhere within the boundary line of the nearest residentially occupied property.

§ 92.03 EXEMPTIONS.

The following shall be exempt from the application of this chapter:

- (H) Noise resulting from construction operations from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on weekdays and from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on weekends for which building permits have been issued or for which building permits are not required; provided that all equipment is in proper operating condition and properly equipped with the manufacturers' mufflers and noise-reducing equipment.
- (I) Noise from lawn mowers and other landscape maintenance equipment used between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on weekdays and from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekends, provided that all equipment is in proper operating condition and properly equipped with the manufacturers' mufflers and noise-reducing equipment
