- Keep garages locked when not in use.

- Trim shrubs to eliminate hiding places.
- Install external security sensor lights.
- Have a peephole in the main door.
- Don't hide keys outside.
- Have your street clearly visible from the street.
- Automatic timing switches for lights, TV etc are excellent, as is a safe for valuables.
- A dog is a good deterrent.
